Today, we will perform this fast, easy, and comfortable screening test as part of your annual comprehensive examination. The \$30 fee for this procedure is not covered by all insurance companies and could be in-addition to your examination fee or vision plan co-pay.

By offering the optomap<sup>®</sup>, the doctor may not need to dilate your eyes. Any questions you have about the optomap<sup>®</sup> Retinal Exam can be directed to the doctor when the images are reviewed during your examination.
