


# Au pair in Italy



About Italy Italy has a rich and colourful history. It has been the home of many European cultures, such as the Etruscans and the Romans, and later was the birthplace of the movement of the Renaissance, that began in Tuscany and spread all over Europe. Italy's capital, Rome, has been the centre of Western civilization, and Vatican City, located in Rome, is the centre of the Catholic Church. The warring factions of the middle ages finally gave way to a nationalist movement in the 19th century, with Italy achieving unification around the turn of the century. Today, Italy is a democratic republic, and a developed country with the 7th-highest GDP, the 8th-highest Quality-of-life index, and the 20th-highest Human Development Index rating in the world. It is a founding member of what is now the European

Union (having signed the Treaty of Rome in 1957), and also a member of the G8, the Council of Europe, the Western European Union, and the Central European Initiative.

# Au pairing in Italy.

### Requirements

- > Between 18-30 years old, single, with no dependants
- ➤ Good/Excellent level of English
- Basic level of Italian would be useful.
- Driver useful, but not essential
- ➤ Available to stay minimum 3 months up to 12 months





**Benefits** The weekly allowance depends on the position you chose:

- ➤ Au pair works minimum of 25 hours per week, which includes 2-3 nights babysitting, 2 days off and receives a minimum 240€ per month
- ➤ Au pair plus works minimum of 35 hours per week, which includes 5-6 hours per day, 2-3 nights babysitting, 1.5 days off and receives
  - > minimum 300€ per month
- Mother's help works minimum of 40 hours per week, which includes 6-7 hours per day, 1-2 evenings babysitting, minimum of 1 free day per week and receives minimum 400€ per month

You will have your own bedroom and full board. Also, you have the possibility to attend Italian classes if you wish to do so. These will be your responsibility to pay for.

## **Required Documents**

- > Application form can be found on our website
- Dear Family letter
- ➤ Photo of yourself
- Minimum 2 references(at least one related to childcare)
- Police check
- Medical certificate



Once you submit your registration, along with the required documents, we will guide you to the next steps of the placement process. We will also arrange a Skype interview to meet you, before arranging any interviews with the families. Also, we will offer you continuous support throughout your placement in Italy. You can contact us by email/phone when you need our advice. Our Italian partner provides a 24 hour contact number, in case of emergency. You will also receive regularly information about other au pairs in Italy.
