Request for Secondary Review of Security Deposit Refund

Once this form is submitted, our review committee will objectively review all information, including your comments, solicit any additional information from the Landlord (in some cases the Tenant) and make any appropriate adjustments. The process will follow these steps:

- 1. Submission of the Request for Secondary Review of Security Deposit (by you)
- 2. Review Committee will re-assess based on all available information including your account.
- 3. Within 10 days of the submission date, you will be notified of the Committee's findings along with any adjustments or explanations.
- 4. <u>Opening up a review can result in adjustments to the deposit based on the findings you will either receive a check or possibly an invoice for additional amounts owed.</u>
- 5. If you remain unsatisfied with the reasoning, we will invite you in to our office to review the pictures, video, and other documentation in an attempt to reach a mutual understanding.
