Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

Symptoms of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder include:

Signs of Inattention:

Difficulty concentrating
Failure to follow-through with tasks,
especially if the child is not interested or motivated
Easily distracted
Looses things
Often forgetful

Signs of Impulsivity:

Difficulty waiting one's turn Interrupting Action before thought

Signs of Hyperactivity:

"Fidgety"
Difficulty sitting still - Constant movement
Often talks excessively

Children with ADHD may also experience memory and learning problems, low self-esteem, and often feel left out socially. They are sometimes argumentative.

There is a full realm of treatment choices to help the ADHD child succeed academically, socially, and behaviorally. Talk to a health care professional to determine which treatments will be most effective for your child.
