Transforming Hearts and Minds for Over 20 Years

HOPE Youth Corps (HYC) is a faith-based service-leadership program designed to engage and inspire high school and college students through hands-on learning. Since 1994, HYC participants have partnered with HOPE worldwide programs all over the world to serve lower-income communities through various outreach and community development efforts. Through the HYC program, student volunteers gain leadership and service experience, they mature spiritually, and build character through compassionate service.

Over the years, participants have served in a countless number of ways. From bandaging the wounds of leprosy patients to caring for orphans and the homeless, HYC participants have helped change lives. They use their hands to build homes for disaster victims, clean and repair orphanages and clinics, and assist medical professionals. They apply their minds in creating and performing street plays about overcoming child abuse. And they pour out their hearts by encouraging the elderly, the sick and the lonely. For over 20 years, next-generation leaders have been transformed by HYC programs around the world.

Enduring Impact

HYC participants build lifelong friendships, amazing memories, a heightened sense of purpose, greater self-confidence and independence, and a better understanding of cultural complexity. Many participants are inspired so much by the experience that they go on to become nurses, doctors, ministers, teachers, counselors, or work with nonprofits to bring needed attention and assistance to the developing world.

Through the HYC experience, participants deepen their compassion and gain a profound appreciation for their own personal circumstances. Fundamentally, HOPE Youth Corps trains a future generation of servant leaders who emerge ready to improve the world around them.

The HYC Scholarship Fund was created to help increase access to the HYC experience. With current participation at nearly 600 participants per year, there are still hundreds of students who cannot attend due to financial hardship. Our vision is to expand this valuable service-learning opportunity to thousands of motivated students with boundless potential. As we grow this vital program we want to ensure access for those with limited financial means.

The Award Process

Each year, the HYC Scholarship Fund selection committee awards scholarships to a limited number of applicants who meet all application requirements yet demonstrate considerable financial need. Any teen or college student may apply; however, awards do not cover all fees for the program. With guidance and support from program staff, candidates will still have some responsibility for raising additional funds necessary to participate in the program.
