BBC CHIEFS TAKING US FOR A RIDE

Exec taxi journeys up 50%

FATCAT BBC chiefs were last night accused of taking licence payers for a ride after spending nearly 50% more on taxis.

Cab journeys by the Beeb's 96 top bosses, who earn over £150,000 a year, now cost nearly £10,000 a month. Over three months that was a 49% increase on the previous three months. And taxi spending rose by 20% in a year, according to figures out yesterday. Among the big claimants was the outgoing chief operating officer Caroline Thomson, 58. She earned £307,000 a year and claimed £1,178 for taxis in July-September

2012. The BBC's creative director Alan Yentob, 65, who is paid £168,300 a year, spent £822 on cabs in his quarterly claim. Matthew Sinclair, chief executive of the TaxPayers' Alliance, said: "Licence fee payers are being taken for a ride. BBC taxi costs were supposed to be coming down, but executives are racking even bigger bills. "The licence fee is too high and cutting these costs would give families a break." But the BBC claimed it had made significant progress in cutting overall expenses for executives, with an 8% annual reduction.
