Here are a few examples to get you started: Now it's time to open up the free turkey in disguise template and click that blue "Make It" button to get started! Assemble your disguise by searching for images like astronaut suits or other fun themes. Let me tell you, I decided to disguise my turkey as an astronaut. Who wouldn't want to escape on a space suit? Click on "Images" and search for what you need - I typed in "astronaut suit clip art" and "moon." Then click the Magic Wand Tool, Erase, Delete, and repeat until the background is gone. Time to get creative with resizing your images! Add some colorful stars and space-related images. Now that our digital disguise is done, let's move on to the printable version. I'm disguising this turkey as Santa Claus - fingers crossed it'll distract those hungry guests! Before we begin, open up the template, click Export Image, and Download to print. Here are the materials you'll need: \* Construction paper \* Pipe cleaners \* Cotton balls \* Stickers \* Scissors \* Circle punch \* Glue Now that we have our materials, let's get started! Draw a circle for the upper body of the turkey and cut it in half to make room for his neck and legs. Cut out a smaller half circle to cover the lower half. Glue those two pieces together to complete his suit. Next, draw a white rectangle and glue it vertically onto the center of the suit. Cut out three small circles for buttons using a circle punch - don't forget to decorate them! Cut pipe cleaners to fit the corners of the suit and create sleeves. Use hot glue to secure them in place. Add cotton balls underneath each pipe cleaner to make sleeve cuffs. Finally, add some decorative touches like stickers or leftover cotton for snowballs. And that's it! You now have your Santa Claus disguise!
