I just wanted to say how much I have enjoyed our training sessions and how much I've learnt from you. As you know my dog, Vinnie started to exhibit very unsociable behaviour towards other dogs when he was on a lead. He would bark, snarl and growl and it became a nightmare to take him anywhere. This was quite distressing and my technique to cope with it became avoidance. It soon became fairly obvious that not only was I making it worse as you can't avoid other dogs for the rest of your life but it was affecting our lifestyle and ultimately the pleasure of owning a dog. I started to walk him in places where it was unlikely I'd meet other dogs and I stopped going to places with him that I had previously enjoyed taking him.

After a very detailed discussion about his behaviour and what we wanted from owning a dog, I was very relieved when you came up with a customised training plan. We set goals and I felt back in control again.

I have gained so much confidence and understanding from the training, it has been the best experience and I wouldn't hesitate to recommend you to anyone who either has a puppy to train or like me has behaviour from their dog that is unacceptable. During my sessions with you it became clear that you have probably dealt with every issue that a dog owner is likely to experience. Your love and passion for dogs and their behaviour was very apparent and heart warming.

I really liked the fact that the whole family was included in the training and of course it is extremely important for dogs to have consistent behaviour from all who handle them on a regular basis. I particularly enjoyed learning about dogs body language and since our training it is something that I've spent a great deal of time studying. I liked the fact that you trained us to train Vinnie and that was so important as the skills you have left us with will be lifelong.

Our training sessions were fun and each one was a different experience, I really looked forward to them and felt quite sad when they were over. I am putting into practice all the things I've learnt on a daily basis and it has just become the way in which we live with our dog. He knows what we expect from him and we get it.

As you know I love my dog very much and he really is part of the family so to now have my well behaved boy back is the best feeling in the world.

We will keep in touch as Vinnie will be coming for regular grooming and no doubt I will be picking your expert brain from time to time. Thank you so much Angie, it was a fantastic experience.
