COVID-19 Plan

2021 Season

This plan is subject to change dependent on new guidelines or directives from the Arkansas Department of Health.

The wearing of face coverings must comply with the Governor's Executive Order(s) and the Face Coverings Directive. This directive requires face coverings at all times, except for persons actively participating in athletic activities when a six (6) feet distance is not achievable and when a face covering is inhibitory to the activity or active exercise. Face coverings that completely cover the nose and mouth are required for everyone 10 years of age or older for indoor and outdoor sports while not actively participating. Children between ages of 2 years and 9 years are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering

Concession Stand

- Markings will be in place 6 feet apart to maintain social distancing while waiting in line
- practices will follow the current Directive Regarding Resuming Restaurant Dine-In Operations

Coaches Duties Before All Practices and Game

- Must self-screen and screen all players prior to entry to the ballfield with provided form and thermometer
- If shared equipment is used, coaches are required to disinfect frequently during each event or between each use.
- Coaches are required to sanitize the dugout after each game
- Face coverings must be worn at all times, except for a brief time when coach or staff member has physically distanced at least 12 feet from athletes and other staff

Pregame and Postgame

- Avoid non-sport-related personal contact at all times. This includes, but is not limited to, huddles, high-fives, hand shaking, fist bumping, and chest bumping
- Coaches and officials will social distance during pregame meetings

Dugouts

- Participants must wear a mask in the dugout when not actively participating
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in each dugout
- Maintain minimum physical distancing of six (6) feet between participants at all times

Equipment

- Each team will be responsible for sanitizing their own equipment
- Home team is responsible for sanitizing game balls
- Participant provided equipment is highly recommended

Spectator Areas

- Proper COVID-19 signage will be placed appropriately throughout the venue
- Tape will be used on bleachers to promote social distancing
- Signs will be posted for the grassy areas encouraging spectators to social distance

- No limitations on who can attend
