Entirely new fittings for the two new smaller bells consisting of oak wheels, tough iron headstocks bored and fitted with steel gudgeons, hard gunmetal bearings fitted in iron pedestals, wrought iron clappers with improved crownstaple joints, ropes of Italian hemp with worsted salleys, rollers, stays, slides, and the requisite smith-work, all of our best, make throughout, fitted to the bells. Also new oak wheels, iron headstocks, steel gudgeons and gunmetal bearings as specified above for the six largest bells.

The six present ropes to be used again. And as to the other fittings, viz. the clappers, stays, &c. these will be carefully examined and only passed for use again if they are as good as new, otherwise they will be replaced by new.

Also new strong and massive iron framework for the eight bells, of improved construction, well braced and firmly bolted together; with stout steel supporting girders, and all requisite stays, plates, bolts, nuts, washers and rivets.

Also taking down the six bells and the old frame, carriage from and to of the bells and of all materials and tools between Evercreech Junction and our works, but exclusive of carting between Evercreech Junction and Ditchat Church.

Hanging the eight bells in the new frame in the tower, in the best ringing order. Including refitting the Chiming Apparatus to the peal of eight, with a new manual fixed in the ringers' chamber, one bell to be arranged for chiming from the ground floor. But exclusive of any work to the floors, hatches, masonry, or clock
