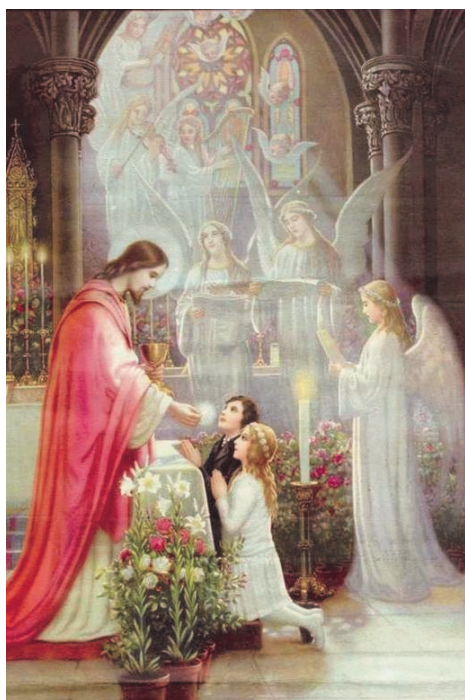

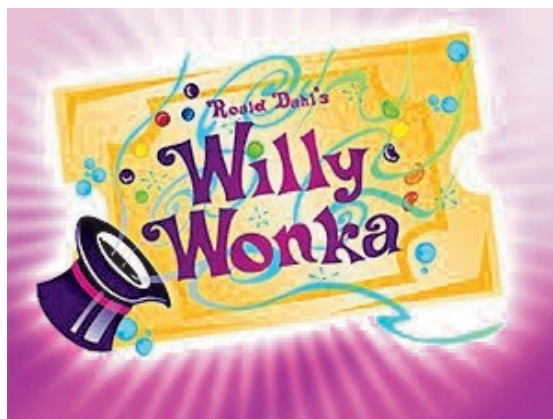

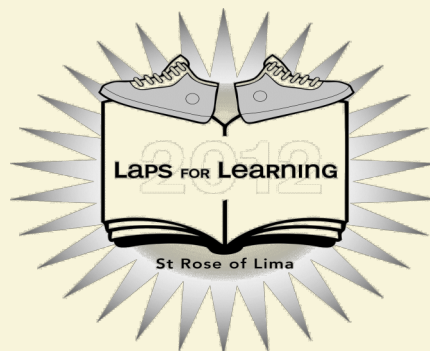
Congratulations St. Rose Relay Teams!!!!
