#### Liability Waiver

I hereby, for myself or the minor child, waive, release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless any and all rights and claims for damages which I may have or may accrue to me against Park's Tae Kwon Do Academy and the Great Lakes Open Championship, and all members of this tournament, volunteers, against any competitor for any and all damages which may be sustained by me or the minor child, in connection with my association with or entry in the Great Lakes Open Championship, or which may arise out of traveling to, participating in, and returning from this tournament. I understand the nature of taekwondo and believe that my experience and capabilities, or that of the minor child, to be qualified to participate in the Great Lakes Open Championship. I understand that taekwondo involves risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death. These risks and dangers may be caused by myself or the minor child's own actions, or inactions, and/or the actions or inactions of others participating in the Great Lakes Open Championship.

I further agree that any pictures taken of me participating in the event may be used for publicity without compensation by the organizers. I understand that modified USTA and WTF competition rules will be used, and that the following sparring equipment is mandatory: uniform (black trim for black belts only), groin protector, mouthpiece, shin/instep pads, forearm pads, helmet and chest protector.

### Form (Poomsae)

The traditional pattern competition shall feature either Taeguk or Palgwe forms for color belt competitors. The following black belt forms shall be used:

Dan	Pattern
1st Degree	Koryo
2nd Degree	Kumkang
3rd Degree	Taebaek
4th Degree	Pyong Won

#### Scoring

- Accuracy of movements, techniques, posture, and balance
- Presentation of energy, power, and rhythm

#### Prizes

Trophies will be awarded for all 1st 2nd and 3rd place pattern competitors.  
 (2 3rd place trophies may be awarded in some matches)

## Breaking

#### Scoring

- Kicking techniques will be scored higher than hand techniques
- Jumping or spinning techniques will be scored higher than standing techniques
- Multiple boards will be scored higher than single boards
- Non spaced boards will be scored higher than spaced boards
- Young competitors may use larger boards to increase their score potential

#### Prizes

Trophies will be awarded for all 1st 2nd and 3rd place breaking competitors.  
 (2 3rd place trophies may be awarded in some matches)

Only wood may be broken. **All competitors will have 1 minute to set up holders.** Competitors must provide holders if they need more than 3. Color belts will have 3 attempts to break per station. Black belts will have 2 attempts per station. Boards must be purchased at the tournament.

The tournament organizers reserve the right to divide or combine categories as required, depending on participation.

### Scoring

#### 11 and Under/All Color Belts

- Full contact to the body—1 point
- Contact to the body resulting in standing 8 count—1 additional point
- No contact to the head permitted

#### Black Belts 12-17

- Full contact to the body—1 point
- Standing 8 count to body—1 additional point
- Controlled head contact—2 points

#### Black Belts 18 and Older

- Full contact to the body—1 point
- Standing 8 count to body or head—1 additional point
- Controlled head contact—2 points

**\*Black belt divisions may use electronic sparring equipment in some rings.**

Warnings and deductions will be issued in accordance with modified USTA rules.

### Equipment

Protective sparring equipment must be USTA approved. Helmet, shin/instep and forearm pads, chest protector, groin protector and mouthpiece must be worn for competition.

### Prizes

Medals will be awarded for all 1st 2nd and 3rd place sparring competitors.  
 (2 3rd place medals may be awarded in some matches)

## Weapons

### Scoring

All weapons will be in the same division. Points will be earned for degree of difficulty, good control, and the accuracy of the techniques used.

## Grand Championship

4 Grand Champion trophies will be awarded this year as decided in a single elimination pattern competition. The Grand Champion Competition will have two belt divisions: Black belts and color belts (red-bodan). There will be two age divisions: 14 and under, and 15 and older. Males and females will compete together.

Forms (Poomsae) will be performed head to head (2/3 competitors) and scored by a panel of judges. From each round, one competitor will advance. Rounds will continue until there is a winner for the division.
