

Entry 2: Read and compare positive temperatures Answers

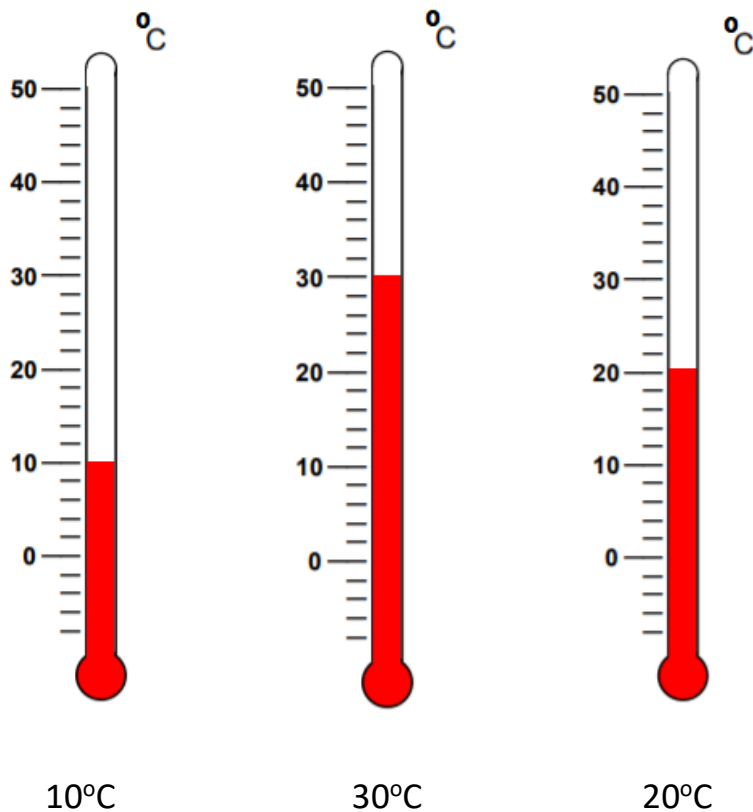
1. Fill in the gaps below.

The short form of writing **20 degree Celsius** is **20°C**.

Water boils at **100 °C**.

Water **freezes** at 0°C.

Order from the highest to the lowest: 30°C, 20°C, 10°C

3. No, 6°C is higher than 4°C.

No, because $6 - 4 = 2$, so it is 2°C.
