They moved from Paxton near Cessnock where both of their families live.

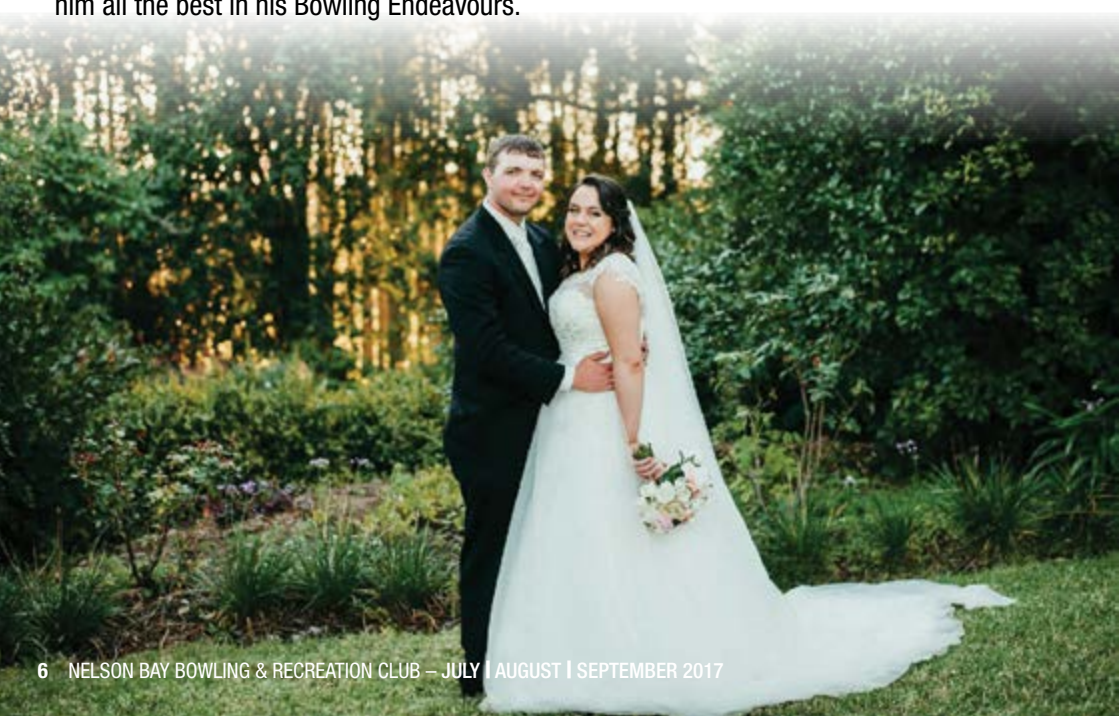
Jake is in his 3rd year of his Apprenticeship and spends 4 days a month at TAFE.

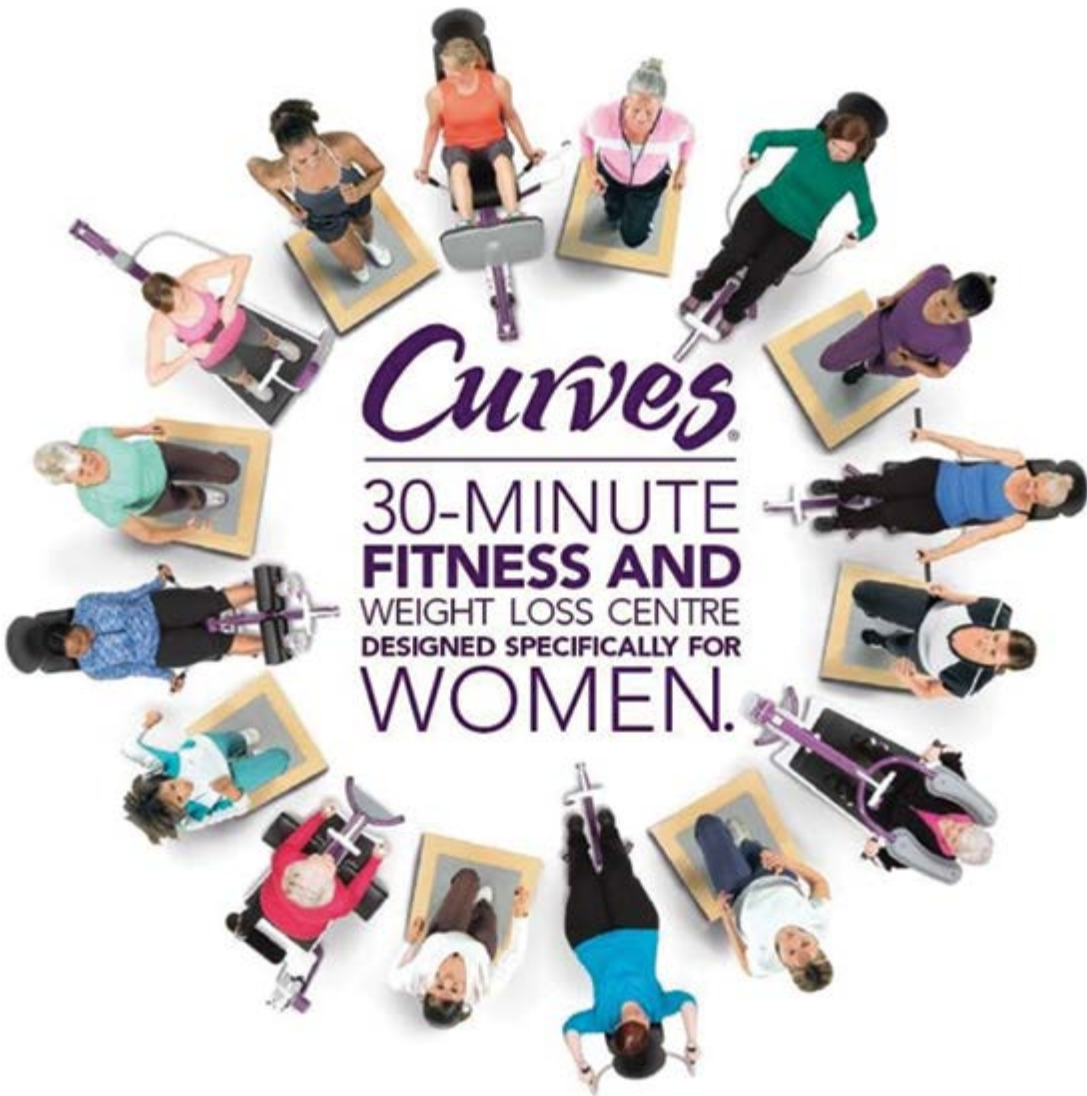

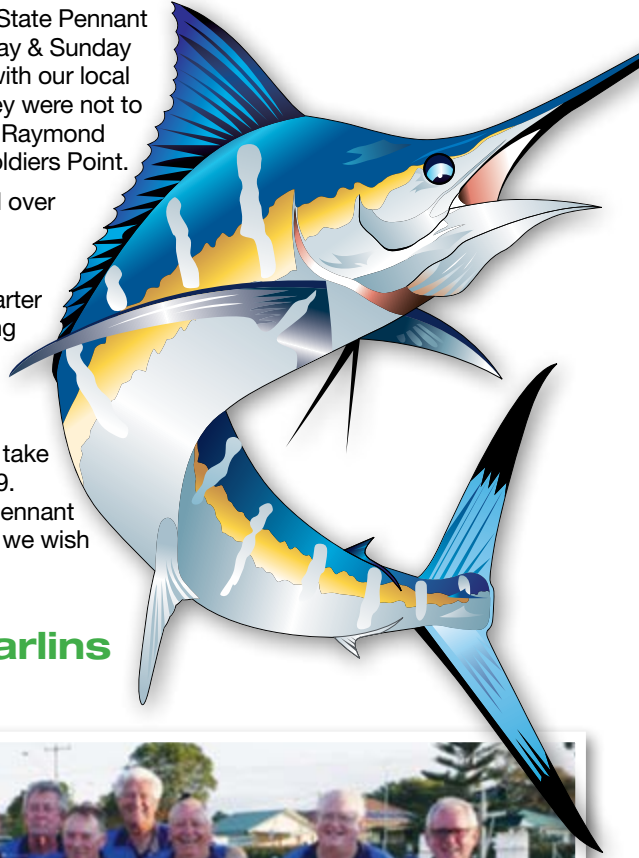
Other Marlin Pennant Grades playing all over the district for a Zone Flag were our Grade 3, 5 & 6's.

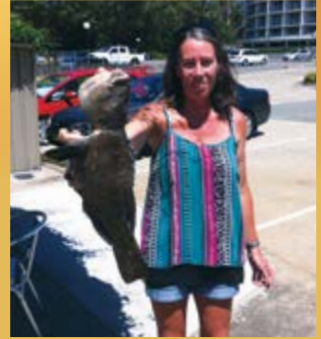
