

Keep Talking and Nobody Explodes Gameplay

About the Game: Keep Talking and Nobody Explodes is a multiplayer party game for two or more players. The objective of the game is to diffuse a bomb before time runs out by using the instructions found in the Bomb Defusal Manual.

How to Play: One player takes the role of the Defuser and access to a virtual bomb with a timer and several different compartments that must be manipulated to stop it from exploding. The Defuser is the only player able to cut the wires, input the codes, turn the dials, and complete any other tasks that can stop the timer. All other players take the role of Experts, and look through the Bomb Defusal Manual to find the specific instructions needed to disarm each component of the bomb. Together, the Experts give verbal instructions to the Defuser on how to stop the bomb, while not actually seeing the bomb themselves.





Supplies required: To play Keep Talking and Nobody Explodes, you need a copy the digital game "Keep Talking and Nobody Explodes" and a system on which to play it. Literacy Link South Central has a copy of this game on Xbox One, but it is also available for:
