

Low Risk 1-day training course

A low risk confined space exists when there is easy entry / exit, no risk of flooding and adequate natural ventilation.

Who should attend?

Those who work in low risk confined spaces. Low risk confined spaces would be associated with lone working, requiring the application of appropriate procedures.
