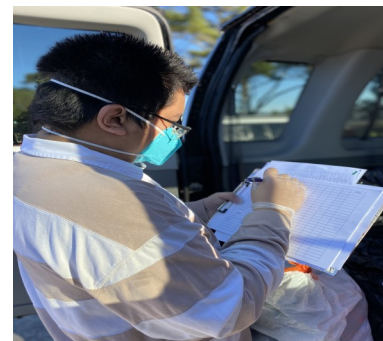

The Advent Collection Drive (Nov 28 - Dec 20) was sponsored by the Hospitality Ministry and Knights of Columbus Council 9714 with the goal of bringing **Hope to the Homeless** during this Christmas Season. Because of the generosity of the parishioners and friends of Saint Augustine Parish, we were able to collect and donate **1,646 In-kind items and \$2,560.00** in total, to St. Vincent de Paul Society-San Mateo District and St. Augustine Conference, Missionaries of Charity of San Francisco and Pacifica, Safe Harbor Shelter (Samaritan House), and Coats for Kids (KofC).
