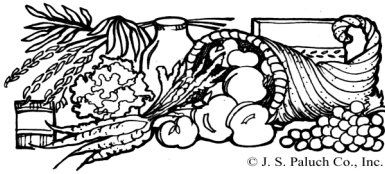

our lives: Food, Stewardship involves thoughtful consumption of resources so all will have enough and the processes that sustain life will not be harmed.

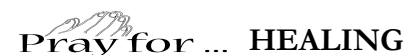
