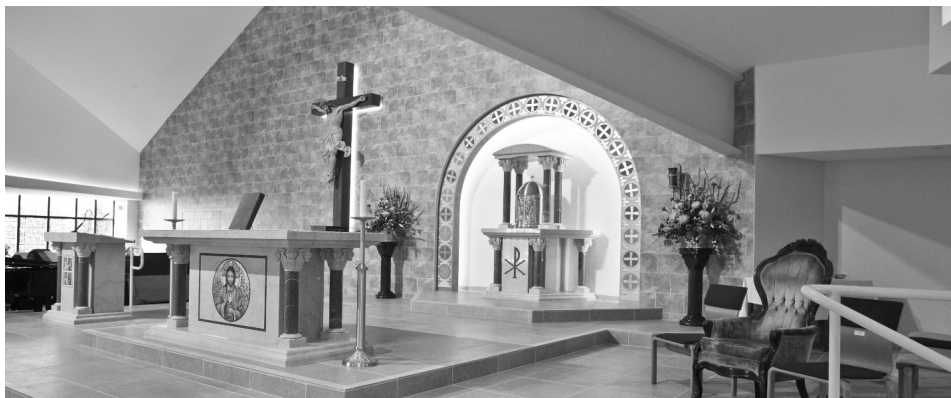

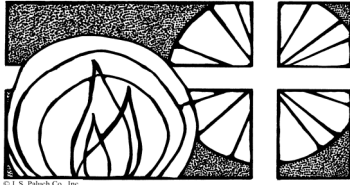

## Third Sunday of Advent

December 16, 2018

The King of Israel, the LORD,  
is in your midst, you have no further misfortune to fear.

— *Zephaniah 3:15b*

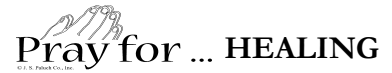
