#### **SANTO NINO CELEBRATION**

The Feast of Santo Nino was celebrated in St. Augustine Church on Saturday, January 23, 2021 at the 10:00 AM Mass outdoors.

Five hundred years after Christianity was introduced in the Philippines, the religious image of the Santo Nino (the Holy Child), continues to unite Filipino Catholic communities around the world. The image was gifted to Queen Juana on the occasion of her baptism by Ferdinand Magellan, a Portuguese explorer. It is housed in the Basilica del Santo Nino in Cebu. It has been venerated for generations and its feast day celebrated in the month of January throughout the Philippines and in many parts of the world, including here in St. Augustine Parish, home to many Filipinos.

This year, through the Santo Nino (although not a liturgical feast on the Church's calendar), the Santo Nino marks a cultural celebration among Filipino Catholics commemorating their history and faith.


