If after combining the Low sections there are less than three (3) entries then competition management must further combine the Low sections with the High sections, allowing each section to compete at their respective height.

High Children's and High Adult Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are less than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are less than six (6) in either section. If after combining the High sections there are less than three (3) entries then competition management must further combine the High sections with the Low sections, allowing each section to compete at their respective height.

AWARDS:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Low Children's Jumper section
- High Children's Jumper section

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR SECTION

- Refer to GR1131

FENCE HEIGHT:

- Fence heights cannot exceed 3'6" and wings are optional
- To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences

COMBINING/DIVIDING SECTIONS:

Competition management may offer Age Group Equitation classes divided at their discretion. Equitation that is offered by age will be awarded points that will be credited to the age groups defined in GR1131.12.a or the relevant Zone Specifications.

AWARDS:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Equitation 14 and Under
- Equitation 15- 17



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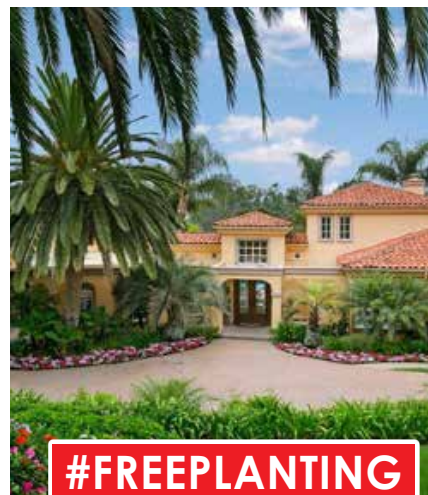
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RULES & REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation of The United States Equestrian Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, news media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the

show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Must be RECEIVED by date indicated on entry blank.

A 3% charge will be added to all fees paid by credit card.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Fees must be paid in U.S. funds. Checks drawn on Canadian banks must be preprinted by a financial institution with the legend "U.S. Funds".
- Visa, Master Card, & American Express are accepted.
- Horse Deposit Fee and all other applicable fees on the Entry Form must be submitted with the Entry Form or the Entry will be considered Late. Any partial payment will be applied to later week entries.
- Entry Form must be completed in its entirety.
- Entry Forms should be mailed to, and checks payable to Nilforushan Equisport Events Attn: Julie O'Connor 8014 Hillcrest Cir, Anaheim CA 92807
- Horse Deposit Fee will be credited to the horse's entries only if the Entry is received by the Closing Date and meets the Entry Procedure.
- Entries received after the Closing Date will be late and subject to the Post Entry Penalty.
- A signed Open Check or Credit Card Authorization must be lodged with the Show Secretary before Numbers are issued.
- Accounts must be closed at the end of each show week. Management will close Exhibitor Accounts that have not been settled at the conclusion of each show.
- Billing questions or refunds will not be considered.

RULES (CONTINUED)

- Back numbers will not be issued until previous week balances are closed.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to close out their account in person. Exhibitors who do not close out in person automatically authorize NEE to close their account using the Check / Credit Card on file. Billing questions or refunds will not be considered.
- The Horse Show policies herein stated regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of GR 912.
- Receipt of any entry form to NEE, submitted by mail, email or electronically, whether bearing signature or not, will constitute an entry and will be subject to the Rules and Regulations of this prize list.

TRAINER'S BARN ACCOUNT

Trainers must create a "Barn Account" Entry Blank if ordering tack stalls, RVs, will order feed/shavings, will do trainer splits.

- Enter the Trainer's info on the Entry Blank in both the Owner and Trainer boxes.
- Enter "Barn Account" on the Entry Blank in the "Horse Name" box.
- Complete a "Barn Account" Entry Blank for each week you will be showing.
- Individual owners/riders should add miscellaneous items like extra stalls, RVs, etc., to their horse's entry blank.

ENTRY CLARIFICATION:

- Classes may only be entered or declared by using a Class Number. A Class Number written on the Entry Form, Add/Scratch Form, or Barn Add/Scratch Form constitutes a Class Entry or Class Declaration.
- An entry with incomplete information for horse, owner, rider or trainer such as a horse entered as "Entry" or "TBA" or any such derivative, will be subject to the \$75 Incomplete Entry Fee. An entry with missing USEF/USHJA numbers or signatures is also subject to this fee.
- Equitation riders must ride the horse and wear the number of the horse they have entered to ride. There is no penalty for the rider to scratch an equitation class from one horse and add it on another horse. Exhibitors who enter an equitation class on one horse and ride or wear another horse's number will be charged on both horses.
- Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which he/she is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the Scratch Procedures outlined below, will be billed for the class.
- Horses shown in a class without being officially entered will be assessed a penalty as shown below
- Exhibitors are responsible for a knowledge of the Rules and Regulations governing the horse show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee, class placing and prize money award.
- Show means the Show Week.

POST ENTRY FEES:

- Entry received after the Closing Date \$50
- Entry made after the Show starts \$50
- Incomplete Entry \$75 (See Entry Clarification above)

ADD/SCRATCH/CHANGE: Any class add, scratch, or change, or any complete Show Scratch must be made in writing in the Show Office on an official form, by letter, or via email, and received prior to the start of the applicable class or show. Scratching a class "at the gate" does not constitute an official scratch. Once a class or division begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched in the Show Office on the day of the class and the Official Show Vet's Certificate must be received that day. Scratch Fee will still apply. A class that has been closed may not be scratched.

- Scratch Class: No charge if scratched before class starts. Once class has started it may not be scratched.
- Scratch Show: \$75
- Scratch Special Class: \$50
- Add Class: No charge if according to procedure above.
- Add Class Late: \$10 if added after 8 am the day of the class.
- Add Nominated Jumper Class: \$10 Day of may go first or last in the Order of Go depending on management's discretion.
- Add Special Class: \$50 Day of unless otherwise noted.
- Horse Substitution: \$85 (\$75 Scratched entry and \$10 Substitute Entry)
- Horse Shown in class but not Entered: \$25 Per class, if not entered in the Show Office according to the procedure above.
- Jumper Nomination: \$75 See "Conditions and Specifications" for a list of jumper divisions requiring a Nomination Fee.

REFUNDS:

- Refund of pre-paid fees will be given for show scratches received prior to or on the Closing Date. Scratches must be made in writing according to the procedure outlined above.
- Refund for Horse Deposits, Stalls, Grand Prix Nominations, RV Sites, or VIP Club will not be given after the Closing Date. Exhibitors are responsible for any such outstanding fees.
- If eligible for refund, a check for refund due less an office fee of \$25 will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the circuit.
- Billing questions or request for refund will not be considered after the show in question.

RULES (CONTINUED)

COMBINING, DIVIDING OR CANCELING DIVISIONS, CLASSES OR CLASSICS:

The Decision to Combine, Cancel or Divide classes will be made at the discretion of Show Management within one hour of the close of the Horse Show Office the night before the class. The update will be noted on the "How Many" schedule on the website.

Combining: Once a class/classic/division has been combined due to insufficient entries, it will not be re-divided for additional entries on the day of the class. **Dividing:** A class/classic/division that has been offered as split may be combined on the day of if scratched entries warrant. Management has the right to run all sections of the class/classic/division in their entirety before pinning if insufficient entries seem likely.

Canceling: A class/classic/division that has been cancelled due to insufficient entries will not be reinstated for additional entries on the day of the class.

MOVE IN / MOVE OUT DATE RESTRICTIONS:

- Move in - Monday at 9:00 AM
- Move out - Monday at noon.

Level 1: Wood Stalls by West Stalls 10x10; Level 2: Chinook Tent Stalls 10x10; Level 3: Permanent Concrete Stalls 12'x12'. Stall Fees are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. Stalls are not transferable or sublettable except within the same trainer group. Bedding on straw prohibited except when the horse's health is at issue Please obtain prior approval. Clean-up fee may apply.

STABLING IS SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY.

RV/CAMPER SPACES

On-site RV spaces include sewer, water and electrical hook-ups. 25 spaces are full hook ups and remaining spaces include 2 pump outs per week. RV spaces are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. RV Spaces may only be ordered on the Entry Form and must be Prepaid.

- RV Weekly: \$300 Monday, noon - Monday, noon of each show week.

VIP CLUB

The VIP Club overlooks the Grand Prix Arena. Tables offer seating for 8 and half tables offer seating for 4. Individual seats are also available. VIP membership includes an OPEN bar, breakfast and lunch daily, and dinner during our evening events. SPACE IS LIMITED. RESERVE YOUR SPACE EARLY. Once ordered, VIP Club fees are non-refundable.

SERVICES:

- **Feed Store:** Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For deliveries prior to or upon arrival, use the Feed Order form in the prize list or online at Jump-NEE.com. Place orders by noon for same-day delivery. Questions with regard to feed and bedding charges will not be considered after noon on Friday. Discrepancies in deliveries will not be considered unless brought to the attention of the Feed Office within 24 hours of placing the order.
- **Horse Watch:** Horses stabled on the show grounds will receive the complimentary service of Horse Watch. Horse Watch extends from approximately 9:00 pm until 5:00 am daily. Horses will be checked approximately six times a night each night of the Show Week, Early Arrival and Off-Week that they are on the grounds. Trainers/owners should provide emergency contact information for Horse Watch personnel. Forms will be available in the Feed Office or in the Prize List on Feed Order form. Cell phone numbers for Horse Watch will be available in the Feed Office for trainers/owners to be able to contact Horse Watch personnel directly.
- **Trainer's Splits:** This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until noon Friday. Only items billed by the horse show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- **Exhibitor Check Cashing:** is not available Please make arrangements with local banks.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS & CREDIT CARDS:

- **Returned Checks:** for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the face value of the Check or Credit Card Charge, whichever is greater. Upon notification, exhibitors will have three days to make full payment, including penalty, in certified funds, cashier's check, money order or by credit card. Sanctioning organizations will be notified if exhibitors fail to pay in full within three days. A monthly service fee equal to 18% per annum will begin accruing after 30 days. Note: First time returned checks will automatically be redeposited.
- A declined credit card will be resubmitted within several days.

RULES (CONTINUED)

- A closed account, stop payment, incorrect or incomplete credit card information or a charge back will be turned over to sanctioning organizations immediately.
- A 3% Retail Adjustment will be applied to all Credit Card transactions.
- Cash Only: may be required if you have previously given a non-negotiable check or Credit Card to NEE. Contact our office.

PRIZE MONEY:

- Prize Money is issued to the Owner, or if provided, the "Recipient of Prize Money" recorded on the entry form. A valid Social Security or Federal ID number must be provided. If the IRS has notified us of a discrepancy in Payee name or SSN / EIN, prize money will be withheld until the discrepancy is resolved. Checks will be mailed or hand-delivered within 30 days after the Show.
- Prize Money Won by Foreign Exhibitors is subject to the US Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a Social Security number and will be asked to complete Form W-8BEN prior to receiving prize money.
- Add Back Prize Money is computed from the number of horses that actually show. Horses entered but not shown forfeit the add back money.
- Prize Money is awarded through 6th place in Hunter classes and through 8th place in Jumper classes unless otherwise noted.

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Owner-Rider-Trainer: Must be members of USEF and USHJA, or pay Show Pass fees.
 - Adult or Amateur Status: Riders showing in classes restricted to Adults or Amateurs must have USEF Amateur Certification.
- FOREIGN EXHIBITOR ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS:
- Owner, Rider, Trainer: Must provide proof in writing (English) that they are a member in good standing of their national federation.
 - Junior, Amateur or Adult Status: Riders showing in classes restricted to Junior, Amateur or Adults present their membership card or other documentation indicating their Junior or Amateur status. Amateurs must provide or sign for USEF Amateur Status. Foreign Amateur Riders must join USEF and Sign for Amateur Status. Exception: Member of EC must sign for Amateur Status but need not join.
 - Horse/Pony Measurement Card: Horse/Ponies showing in Junior Hunter, Pony Hunter, Children's Pony Hunter or Pony Jumpers must have a USEF Measurement card or be measured at the show. Foreign measurement cards are not acceptable as proof of measurement.

ASSOCIATION HORSE REQUIREMENTS:

- Horse Fee: PCHA \$3, USEF \$8, USHJA \$7
- Horse Drug Fee: CDFA \$5, FEI \$25 (for World Cup horses), USEF \$15.
- High Performance Fees: Horses entered in Grand Prix are required to pay the \$35 IHP Fee up to a total of the cap of \$420 per competition year. Please refer to the USEF website for additional information.
- Horse/Pony Measurement Card: Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, and Pony Jumpers must have a valid USEF Measurement Card or copy of a valid Measurement Form, or be measured.
- USEF Horse Recording: Horses must be Recorded with USEF Annually or for Life in order to be eligible for HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards.
- USHJA Horse Registrations: All horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Eq competitions must have or obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. PRESENTATION OF CREDENTIALS: THE SHOW SECRETARY WILL NOT ISSUE A NUMBER TO ANY EXHIBITOR UNTIL ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET. ONCE THE NUMBER IS ISSUED, ASSOCIATION FEES, INCLUDING SHOW PASS, WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED FOR THAT SHOW. Failure to provide proper credentials will result in show pass fees and/or Incomplete Entry fees charged in each incident. NOTE: The Exhibitor has the ultimate responsibility for proper registration of horse, owner, rider and trainer with USEF / USHJA and for entering the horse under proper ownership where points are concerned.
- Membership: Present to the Show Secretary proof of current membership, join at the show, or pay Show Pass fees.
- Horse Recording: Present to the Show Secretary proof of USHJA or apply at the Show. Horses must be Recorded with USEF Annually or for Life in order to be eligible for HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards and to compete in a Grand Prix.
- Horse/Pony Measurement Card: Present to the Show Secretary proof of Measurement or have horse/pony measured at the Show.

FACILITY INFORMATION:

- Footing at Galway Downs is all-weather. The Grand Hunter Arena is on grass.
- Ring sizes may change from show week to show week and notice will be posted in the Show Office.
- Food Service will be available every day.
- Lunging will be allowed in the designated areas only.

HEALTH & VETERINARY:

- Sharps & Medical Waste must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
- Show Veterinarian is in residence on the show grounds. The Vet's phone number will be posted at the Show Office.
- Equine Health Requirements will be enforced. All horses

RULES (CONTINUED)

(competing or not) that enter the grounds are required to present the Required Health Entry Requirements, including the Event Participation Declaration and Proof of Vaccination. All horses are subject to examination by NEE officials/designated representatives and/or state officials (collectively "officials") for determining whether such animals are, have been infected/exposed, or are likely to become infected with an infectious or contagious disease. If after such examination, officials have reason to believe that an animal's health condition places other animals at risk, such officials, at their sole discretion, may quarantine such animal (and others that may have been infected/exposed) or, if appropriate, require that such animals be transported off the grounds. All participants agree to fully cooperate with event officials and abide by their decisions and instructions. Failure to comply shall be grounds for immediate expulsion and potential disciplinary action by organization, state/local or federal animal health officials. All exhibitors are encouraged to review the equine health entry/transport requirements of the destination state prior to entry. Additional information can be obtained from the State Vet Office.

SAFETY

Accidents Involving Competitors. GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

- **Protective Headgear:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee and Licensed Official are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. GR 801.2,7.
- **Motorized Vehicles and Golf Carts:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are

solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being levied against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- **Dogs must be restrained on the show grounds:** Loose dogs will be picked up and detained and the owner fined \$100. The owner may be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds for a second offense, or for refusal to pay the fine, and will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- **Electrical/Fire Regulations:** Electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable Liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse. Additional appliances are not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to confiscation of the item(s).
- **Exterior Tent alterations are strictly forbidden.** The removal of stall tent side poles, side ropes and/or stakes/anchors is strictly prohibited. Any exhibitor found in violation will be issued a single warning. If violation continues, Management reserves the right to remove from the show grounds all property belonging to or under the control of said violator. Further, Management reserves the right to bar any exhibitor found to be in violation from any further participation in the horse show without recourse to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due.
- **Damage:** Owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
- **Alcoholic Beverages** in any form may not be brought onto the show grounds.

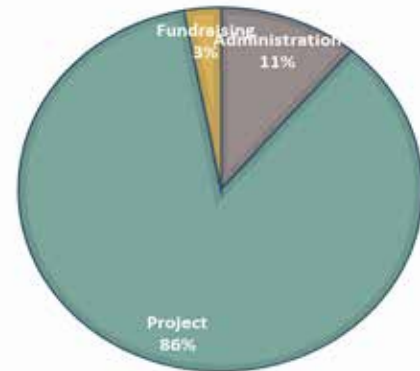

GENERAL

Poling: Poling is prohibited in the State of California.

Entries May Close: Trainers and Exhibitors are advised that Management may elect to exercise its right to close entries for certain classes. Exhibitors are advised to keep this in mind when submitting their original Entry Form.

Show Weeks May Close: Exhibitors are advised that some show weeks may sell out. After the Closing Date of Entries, priority is given to exhibitors who enter two or more show weeks.

Awards: Ribbons are available to eighth place in all classes. If you would like to donate your ribbon, the value of said ribbon will be donated to charity.

International Riders: All classes held will be run under National rules with regard to riders with the exception of the FEI classes, when applicable. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a 1st come, 1st served basis.

HUNTERS

General: All classes in rated hunter divisions will be judged on performance and soundness and when indicated, conformation, suitability or manners.

Jog: The following sections will not jog: Schooling, Low, Young, Adult, Children's, Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Cross Rails, and Green Rider.

Hunter Champion and Reserve: Awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences. In addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model.

Warm-Up: Complimentary Warm up on Tuesday from 9 AM - 5 PM in our sand hunter arenas.

2018 Zone 10 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Adult Hunters:** Horses and ponies. Horses or riders may not cross enter into any A-O Hunter Class, except the U/S. Riders may not cross enter into Green 3'6", Green 3'9" or High Performance at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Adult Jumpers, Jr/Am Mod Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence height.

- **Children's Hunters:** Horses and ponies. Horses/Ponies or riders may not cross enter into any 3'6" Jr. Hunter Class, except the U/S. Riders may not cross enter into Green Hunter 3'6", Green Hunter 3'9" or High Performance at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences exceeding 3'3" except Child Jumpers, Jr/Am Mod Jumpers, Eq. and Medal Classes. Exception: Riders in Child Hunter Pony may only cross enter into Children's Jumper. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence height. If Child Hunter Pony is offered, fences must be set at 2' for small/mediums and 2'6" for larges.
- **Green Hunter 3' & 3'3":** A horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over fences 3' to 3'3", and that has never shown over fences 3'6" or higher. Fences 3' or 3'3". Horses may not cross enter into 3'6" divisions. Refer to HU106.3 for additional information.
- **Hunters General:** Spreads not to exceed fence height. No jog.

JUMPERS

Jumper Nomination Fee: \$75

Nominated Jumper Sections: 120m-1.40m, 1.45m, Grand Prix, A-O/Amateur, and Junior Jumper.

Non-Nominated Jumper Sections:

.70m-1.15m, Adult, and Children's.

Eligibility: Any horse, regardless of winnings, is eligible to enter any .70m-1.45m and Open Jumper class.

Declarations: Nominated Jumpers must declare on the appropriate form in the Show Office by 5 pm the day before the class is to be held. Late declarations will be subject to the Post Entry Penalty and may require the horse to work first or last in the order of go at management's discretion. Classes may be scratched the day of prior to the class starting with no penalty - exception: Special Classes. Classes entered on the Entry Blank constitute a Declaration.

Jumper Tables: Refer to the Time Schedule.

Time Allowed: The Time Allowed will be based on a speed of 382 yards per minute for all sections unless otherwise noted, and may be adjusted accordingly.

Martingales: 1.30m or below: No martingale restrictions when used in a conventional manner. Draw Rein/German Martingales: allowed when schooling or in classes 1.20m or below that do not offer prize money. Above 1.30m (and all classes restricted to young horses): Only running martingales used in the conventional manner. Note: Ponies may not be ridden by a Junior in draw reins or German martingales at any time.

Ties: Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated.

24 Hour Rule: Horses must be stabled on the grounds 24 hours prior to any class with prize money of \$25,000 or more. 2018 Zone 10 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

CONDITIONS & SPECS (CONTINUED)

2018 Zone 10 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Children's and Adult Jumpers:** Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Junior or Amateur-Owner Jumper class at the same show. Exception: Low Junior and Amateur-Owner Jumper at Temecula Valley National Horse Show, where fence height is 3'11". Riders may not cross enter into any Jumper class at the same show with fences exceeding 1.20m (3'11"). Fences 1.0m-1.05m (3'3"-3'5") for Low. Fences 1.10m (3'7") in the first class, 1.10m-1.15m (3'7"-3'9") in succeeding classes for High.

SPECIAL CLASSES

The General Rules and Regulations of the Horse Show will prevail for the Special Classes except as provided for each individual class and as noted herein.

American Standard Grand Prix -

- 1.40m - 1.45m with spreads to 1.60m, excluding Triple Bar and Water Jump. At least 4 Verticals and 2 Oxers must be set at 1.45m. The maximum spread for the Triple Bar is 1.80m, and the maximum spread for the Water Jump is 3.80m.
- **Specs:** Table II.2.a. American Standard.
- **Horse Limit:** Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride.

Special Hunter Classics: Judged on performance and soundness with manners and suitability emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 15 (or 1/3) horses (ponies) from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied will be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, judges will confer to break the tie. All other ties will remain and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons.

- **Separate Two Round Classic** - For the first round, each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10-12 fences at the required height.
- **Designated First Round Classic** - A designated class of the Division will be the first round of the Classic. You must enter the Classic prior to the start of the first round class. Scratches are not permitted after the First round class has begun. See Time Schedule for Designated First round class.

Special Class Nomination/Declaration: Special Classes added on the day of or after the Order of Go has been drawn will be required to work first in the order.

Special Class Scratch: Any scratch must be made before the class starts. See Rules & Regulations for more information.

- **Classics / Grand Prix:** In the event of scratch on the day of the class, horses are subject to the Classic / Grand Prix Scratch Fee.

Order of Go: The Order of Go will be drawn. In the jump-off, if any, all horses will go in the original drawn order

Attire: Formal attire required in Special Classes.

Awards: Winners to ride for presentation of awards in Special Classes.

Trophy & Ribbons: 1-8 (unless donated) or 1-12 in Special Classes unless otherwise stated.

Show Champion or Circuit Champion: Classics will not count toward Show or Circuit Champion



Equine Health Entry Requirements

Protecting the health of your horse and other horses at the Temecula Valley National Horse Show is of the utmost importance to Nilforushan Equisport Events. We are implementing Required Biosecurity Measures to decrease the risk of introduction and/or spread of contagious or infectious disease at its shows.

Horses must arrive only between the hours of 8 am - 5 pm daily. Off-hours arrival must obtain permission from Show Management 24 hours prior to arrival.

UPON ARRIVAL TO GALWAY DOWNS, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE/PROVIDE:

EVENT PARTICIPATION DECLARATION (REQUIRED):

Signed by the owner/agent/trainer verifying that the horse has been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and has not had a fever above 102°F within 72 hours (3 days) of arrival. The Event Participation form must be each time the horse enters the property. Event Participation Declaration Form available in this prize list and at Jump-NEE.com.

PROOF OF VACCINATION (REQUIRED):

Via a signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **Equine Influenza**

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **EHV 1 and EHV 4**

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for that show.

PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS (REQUIRED):

The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non-Showing.

These documents must be in the Show Office before any competition numbers will be issued. In addition, random checks for Equine Health Requirements will occur. Be sure to keep a copy of all of your horse's Equine Health Requirements in an easily accessible spot (in your tack room or tack trunk, truck or trailer) to ensure you can comply with this requirement. The results on all required papers must indicate the horse's registered (show) name.

Any horse not accompanied by these documents will be directed to the Show Veterinarian to obtain the required documents and/or vaccinations, and/or will be placed in quarantined stabling until the proper documents are obtained. Any horse showing signs of fever/illness/stress is subject to examination by NEE Officials and/or the Show Veterinarian, who may at their sole discretion, place the horse in quarantined stabling or take further action if deemed necessary.

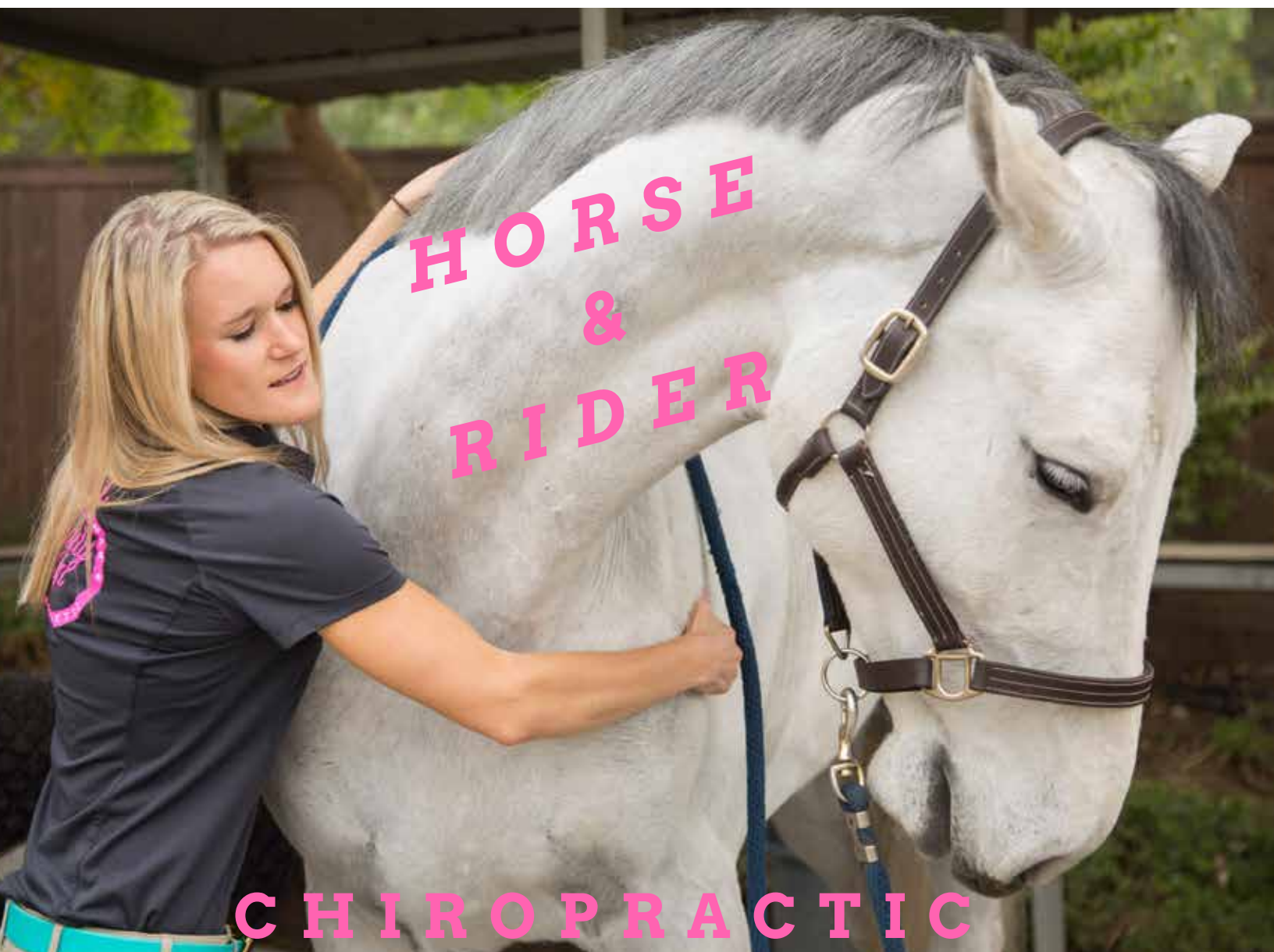

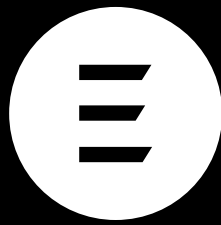
