

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMOUR

BY-LAW #29-2010

Being a by-law to provide notice for permanently closing a highway
and that by-law #10-2001 is hereby repealed.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, Chapter M.25, provides for a municipality to give public notice regarding permanently closing of a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Armour deems it desirable to create a by-law to provide for the giving of notice;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Armour enacts as follows:

1. That the notice policy for permanently closing a highway attached hereto as Schedule "A" form part of this by-law;
2. That if the provisions of this by-law conflict with any other by-law of the Corporation heretofore passed the provisions of this by-law shall prevail;
3. That this by-law shall come into force on the final passing hereof.

SCHEDULE “A” TO BY-LAW #29-2010

TOWNSHIP OF ARMOUR NOTICE POLICY FOR PERMANENTLY CLOSING A HIGHWAY

PUBLIC NOTICE

1. The Municipality shall give notice to the public of a proposed permanent closing of a highway as follows:
 - (a) by publishing a Notice at least once in a newspaper having local circulation in the Municipality at least three weeks prior to any final consideration of the proposed closing by Council;
 - (b) by posting the Notice for at least three weeks in two of the most public places in the immediate vicinity of the highway proposed to be closed and in the municipal office prior to any final consideration of the proposed closing by Council;
 - (c) by posting the Notice on the Municipality’s website for at least three weeks prior to any final consideration of the proposed closing by Council.
2. The Notice shall include the following:
 - (a) the date, time and location of the public meeting at which Council will give consideration to the proposed closing;
 - (b) the name of a contact person who could provide more information regarding the proposed closing;
 - (c) a statement that anyone wishing to comment on the proposed closing may do so by delivering such comment in writing to the Clerk of the Municipality on or before a date specified in the Notice;
 - (d) a statement that any comments received shall be considered by Council which, in its sole discretion, shall decide what action, if any, should be taken.
