MUNICIPALITIES OF ARMOUR, BURK'S FALLS & RYERSON BURNING BYLAW REGULATIONS



BURNING GRASS

You can burn areas of grass or leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy or give permission to burn grass and leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy, without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:

- The fire is only allowed if the Burk's Falls & District Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a <u>TOTAL FIRE</u> <u>BAN</u>. (Check with your Municipal Office)
- From November 1st and until March 31st burning may be permitted in the daytime.
- NO DAY TIME BURNING From April 1st. to October 31st a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of 6.00pm. in the evening to 10.00am in the morning.
- The total area to be burned does not <u>exceed one hectare.</u> (2.5 Acres)
- <u>The flaming edge</u> of the fire <u>does not exceed 30 meters</u> (100ft) in length.
- <u>A responsible person</u> tends the fire until it is extinguished.
- You have <u>adequate tools and water</u> to contain the fire to the fire site.
- The <u>property owner</u> is still <u>/iab/e</u> if the fire is not contained.
