## INCINERATOR BURNING

You can burn wood, brush, leaves or wood by-products only, (no kitchen garbage, or any material prohibited by the Environmental Protection Act) in an incinerator, without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:

- The fire is only allowed if the Burk's Falls & District Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a <u>TOTAL</u> <u>FIRE BAN</u>.(Check with your Municipal Office)
  - From November 1<sup>st</sup> and until March 31<sup>st</sup> burning may be permitted in the daytime.
  - <u>NO DAY TIME BURNING From April 1st. to October 31st</u> a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of <u>6.00pm in the evening to 10.00am in the morning.</u>
  - The incinerator is an enclosed device constructed <u>entirely of non-combustible material.</u>
  - A screen having a mesh size of <u>not more than five millimeters (1/4")</u> covers the incinerator.
  - The incinerator is at least <u>six meters (20ft)</u> from <u>any forest or woodland.</u>
  - The incinerator is at least <u>six meters (20ft)</u> from <u>any flammable or combustible material.</u>
  - A <u>responsible person</u> monitors the fire until it is <u>extinguished</u>.
  - The <u>property owner</u> is still <u>liable</u> if the fire is not contained.
