Roads Department:

The Roads Department is gearing up for another busy season. Road rehabilitation projects are scheduled for Pevensey Road, Leggetts Road and Pickerel & Jack Lake Road this year along with ongoing routine maintenance. Building Department:

Structural additions or improvements require a Building Permit. Applications are available on our website or at the municipal office. Your property's zoning will determine what you can build on your property. Site plan control may also apply. Contact the office early in your planning process to receive specific information about the requirements. By-Law Enforcement:

<u>DOG LICENCES</u>: Annual licenses are now available for 2019. Fees are: \$15.00 for the first dog + \$20.00 if you have 2 dogs + \$25.00 if you have 3 dogs. Licenses may be purchased at the Township Office or by contacting our By-law Enforcement Officer, Jason Newman at 705-349-1150, or by email at bylaw@armourtownship.ca

TRAILER LICENCES: The use of trailers is only permitted in certain zones within the Township. The annual fee for 2019 is \$530.00. Check out the Trailer License By-Law & application on our website or contact the Municipal Office for more information.

SHIPPING CONTAINERS: Use of shipping containers is permitted in certain zones, provided they are used only as an accessory structure, and you have a building permit. A principle use residence must also exist. Please contact the Municipal Office prior to placing a shipping container on your property.

Landfill:

Hazmat Days for the TRI-R Landfill are May 25th and August 24th - 10:00 am to 2:00 pm, both days at the Strong Township Landfill, 483 Forest Lake Road.

Our new Landfill Cards are out. The system makes your card reusable & trackable. Working off a gift card system, the cards will be reloaded over the internet each year with an amount predetermined by Council. Lost or stolen cards can be deactivated and the remaining value can be reloaded to a replacement card. The same goes for defective cards - "magnetic strip no longer works" - we'll replace that one too. Temporary passes for cottage rentals are still available by making arrangements with the Municipal Office.
