## THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMOUR

## BY-LAW #17-2020

Being a by-law to set and levy the Rates of Taxation in the Township of Armour for the year 2020

**WHEREAS** it is necessary for the Council of the Township of Armour, pursuant to the Municipal Act, to raise certain sums for the 2020 taxation year;

**AND WHEREAS** all property assessment rolls on which the 2020 taxes are to be levied have been returned and revised pursuant to the provisions of the Assessment Act subject to appeals at present before the District Court and the Ontario Municipal Board;

**AND WHEREAS** "Residential/Farm Assessment", "Multi-Residential Assessment", "Commercial Assessment", "Industrial Assessment", "Pipeline Assessment", "Farmland Assessment", and "Managed Forest Assessment", as defined in the Assessment Act, as amended by the Fair Municipal Finance Act, 1997 and further amended by Regulations thereto, have been determined on the basis of the aforementioned property assessment rolls;

**AND WHEREAS** the tax ratios on the aforementioned property for the 2020 taxation year have been set out in By-law #16-2020 of the Township of Armour;

**AND WHEREAS** the tax rates on the aforementioned property classes and property subclasses have been calculated pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act and the manner set out herein;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Municipal Corporation of the Township of Armour enacts as follows:

a)	That the 2020 current municipal budget be adopted in the following amounts:

c) The Current Taxes shall become due and payable in 2 installments as follows: 50 percent of the final levy shall become due and payable on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2020; and the balance of the final levy shall become due and payable on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020. Non-payment of the amount on the date stated in accordance with this section shall constitute default.

A penalty shall be charged as follows:

1.25% on the first day of default plus an additional 1.25% on the first day of every calendar month thereafter in which the taxes remain unpaid.

- 2. For payments in lieu of taxes due to the Township of Armour under the Municipal Act, actual amounts will be based on the assessment rolls and the municipal rates of taxation for the year 2020.
- 3. The Clerk of the Township of Armour is hereby authorized to make any minor modifications or corrections of an administrative, numeric, grammatic, semantic or descriptive nature or kind to the by-law and schedule(s) as may be deemed necessary after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.

4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect as of the date of passing.
