Soft Contact Lens Policy

Prior to a contact lens fitting or refitting examination, a patient must have received a full eye examination in the last two years. The total cost of a contact lens fitting varies based on the type of contacts the patient needs and the complexity of the fitting.

The new contact lens wearer fitting fee includes:

- +a contact lens exam
- +all follow-up evaluations with the doctor as needed for up to 90 days
- +diagnostic contact lenses used for the fitting along with a contact lens solution starter kit
- +AND a contact lens training class to instruct on insertion, removal and safety protocol for wearing contact lenses. (Contact lenses are sold separately).

First time contact lens wearers:

The patient is **required** to attend a contact lens instruction appointment to learn insertion, removal, and care of the new contacts lenses. Upon successful completion of this appointment, the patient will wear a diagnostic pair of contact lenses for one week or as instructed, and will return to our office for a follow-up evaluation. When the doctor is satisfied that the patient has a proper fit, the contact lens prescription will be finalized and the patient may purchase a supply of lenses.

The contact lens fitting fees are as follows:

Soft spherical fitting	\$100.00
Soft toric fitting (astigmatism)	\$175.00
Soft bifocal fitting	\$200.00
