



PE and Sports Funding at CTK

We will spend our Sports Grant Premium on in 2014-2015:

At Christ the King Catholic Primary School, the Sports Premium we received for 2014-2015 was £8,600 for 120 pupils, this was made up of:

- £8000 lump sum;
- £600 pupil number;

We will spend this funding as follows:

- Membership of the Castle Partnership, to organise interschool competitions and festivals for all year groups
- Release time for PE Leader and teachers to attend competitions
- CPD for teaching staff in PE and sport
- A member of staff to be trained in Dance and Gymnastics working alongside our local secondary school
- Development of a new annual sports week for all children to experience new sports from 24th June to 27th June linking with the National Sports Week
- PE equipment audit and update of all resources
- A netball court on the KS2 playground to enhance our provision
- Sports kit for all representational teams
- Specialist coaches to deliver cricket to Yr2 to Yr6 and multi sports to Yr1 and Foundation children in terms 5 and 6
- Membership of the Youth Sports Trust and explore how to work towards the Kitemark for Active Sport
- An opportunity to develop our pupil's sporting skills through providing sporting club, specialist coaching and develop staff CPD (Continuing Professional Development) to enhance our PE provision and provide quality PE throughout the school
