## IMPACT



For every \$1 of private funding the Coalition receives, we bring more than \$26 in public funding to the Houston region to solve homelessness - more than \$52 million in 2018.



More than 18,000 people housed since 2012 with an 84% success rate.



A 54% decrease in overall homelessness since 2011 in Harris, Fort Bend, and Montgomery Counties.



A decrease from 1 in 450 people in 2011
