# Water Main Replacement Project

In an effort to save time and money, the Village has decided to work in conjunction with the Lenawee County Road Commissions plans to reconstruct Main St and Slee Rd, in order to replace the Main St. portion of our 70-year-old watermains. The Water and Sewer Committee and Village Council have been working with engineers, the State of Michigan, financial advisors and financial institutions to prepare for this large undertaking. We are excited that after many years of conversations this is finally happening.

The village has been in discussions with our municipal advisor regarding refinancing our sewer bond loan to lower the interest rate on our Sewer System Expansion Bond potentially saving the village over \$800,000 over the course of the loan. We have an offer from a banking institution and will be working out the details in the next few months

After many months of careful review of water and sewer rates, the council has adopted a new REU (Residential Equivalent Unit) rate schedule.
