



Fire Hydrant Flushing Notification for the Village of Onsted

Fire hydrants will be flushed throughout the Village of Onsted beginning April 13th and continuing for two weeks or until completed. During (or shortly after) this time you may notice low water pressure and discoloration of the water due to rusty water being flushed from the distribution system. Although this discolored water may be upsetting, it is, however, **completely safe**. Please take a moment to examine the water prior to laundry, cooking, etc. for a discoloration. If it is observed simply, turn on your plumbing fixtures (starting with an outside spigot) for a few minutes until the water runs clear. We realize that this may cause some inconvenience, however, the flushing program is an integral part of maintaining a good water supply for both firefighting and domestic consumption.
