



Level 2 Diploma for Hair Professionals (Hairdressing)

Apprentices must be employed by a salon for at least 30 hours per week.

Finding a suitable employer

Once you are enrolled on an Apprenticeship

Apprentices:

- will attend the Academy one day a week for practical and theory training
- will be given assessment opportunities during the practical classes
- will need to provide their own equipment i.e. combs, scissors, sectioning clips
- will be in training for 18-24 months
- will need to provide your own models for assessment purposes
- will take part in the End Point Assessment

What you will be studying (Hairdressing)

- Style and finish hair using a range of techniques to create a variety of look
- Cut hair using a range of techniques to create a variety of looks
- Colour and lighten hair using a range of techniques
- Consultation
- Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Perming hair

End Point Assessment

Once all assessments have been completed then you will be put forward for the End Point Assessment. You will be given the criteria and the types of models you will need to require. The assessment will last at least 6 hours and you will require at least 2 models. You will be graded either a pass or a distinction.

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
