- Learning about the scholarly research and writing process, and
- Accessing information from the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th ed.).



WHAT IS ACADEMIC WRITER?

YOUR ACADEMIC WRITER ACCOUNT

You are required to create an account to

- Access Academic Writer through your course management system (such as Blackboard, Brightspace, Canvas, or Moodle).
- Create and save references and papers.
- Save lessons and samples to a list of favorites.

An Academic Writer account is not automatically created for you; you must create your own account. (You are not required to use your institutional email address, but it is recommended that you use an email account that you check regularly.)

Academic Writer Home

Access center descriptions and links.

- Access the Learning Center, Reference Center, and Writing Center.
- Access quick links to your collection of references, papers, and favorites.

Reference Center

Create a personal library of APA Style-formatted references.

- Create references using forms, importing RIS files, and searching adapted APA PsycInfo references.
- Add notes and specific quotations to your saved references to help you easily search your collection.

Learning Center

Learn more about APA Style guidelines and scholarly research and writing through lessons and samples.

- Quick guides (APA Style guidelines)
- Tutorials (Scholarly research and writing)
- Samples (Papers, tables, figures, and references)

Writing Center

Write and collaborate on papers and use tools to help you format your paper, citations, and reference list.

- Paper templates
- Research Lab Book tools to help you select a research topic, plan your research, create an annotated bibliography, and track original research.

STARTING PAPERS

- 1. Navigate to the Writing Center or use the **Write a New Paper** button from the Academic Writer homepage.
- 2. Select a template based on your assignment instructions or other requirements.
- 3. Enter a title.
- Start writing! (Or add some references you already know you'll use in your paper.)

- · Reports original research

- · Synthesizes the results of multiple studies of a phenomenon
- · Summarizes a body of literature in terms of its impact, limitations, and implications

Multiexperiment Paper

- · Reports original research
- · Presents data from multiple linked

Case Study Paper

- · Reports case material from an individual, group, community, or organization
- Implements qualitative, quantitative, or mixed-method approaches
- View sample paper

Reaction Paper

- · Presents personal opinions, reactions, or critique of one or more
- · Develops writers' critical thinking

Literature Review Paper


- · Critically evaluates previously published works
- · Analyzes research and draws new conclusions
- Tiview sample paper

Methodological Paper


- · Presents a new methodology or analyzes existing methodology
- · Applies the methodology to an identified problem
- la View sample paper

- · Provides a blank template
- Style paper










Enter a Paper Title

To get started, please enter a paper title. Once you have provided the title, select Start Writing to begin by writing your text or using research planning tools, or select Add References to begin by creating your reference list. Once you enter a title, your paper will be automatically saved in My Papers, which you can access from My File Cabinet in the top navigation bar. You can change your paper title at any time by updating it in the Title section of the Title Page menu in the online editor.

Definitions

Reference – Bibliographic information for a resource included at the end of your paper Citation – Specifically formatted mention of a resource in the text or body of your paper


Academic Writer Terminology

My References – References you've saved to your account; you can use and reuse these in as many papers as you like.

Paper Reference List – References you've added to a specific paper. You can view these below the paper editor, along with other paper elements such as tables and figures.


Find and Cite Reference – The Academic Writer tool that allows you to search My References, the Paper Reference List, or add a new reference, to help you format your intext citations.







