

Most fluorescent tubes contain mercury, a toxic material which is environmentally hazardous if disposed of incorrectly. Disposing of large amounts of mercury containing lamps in landfill is forbidden in most states. The mercury, as well as the glass, phosphor and aluminum contained in the lamps can be safely recovered and reused.
