



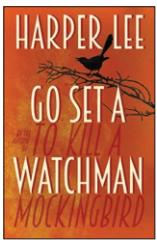

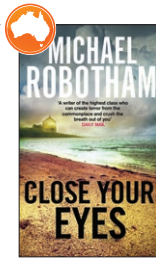
### THE GIRL IN THE SPIDER'S WEB
