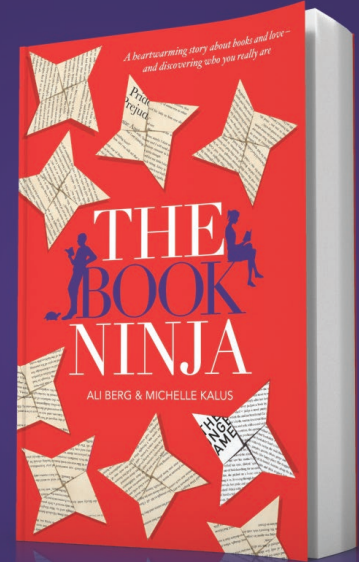
Frankie Rose is desperate for love. Or a relationship. Or just a date with a semi-normal person will do.
