

Sermon Title: **“THE STRONG LIFE: LIVING STRONG IN A SINFUL & BROKEN WORLD!”**

Sermon Text: **Psalms 73**

Introduction:

GOOD MORNING TO ALL! WE THANK THE LORD FOR ANOTHER BEAUTIFUL SUNDAY MORNING THAT HE HAS GIVEN US. IF YOU ARE COMING FOR THE FIRST TIME, WE ARE NOW STUDYING THE BOOK OF PSALMS UNDER THE THEME “PONDERINGS ON THE PSALMS: FINDING MEANING & PURPOSE IN THE PANDEMIC!”

THIS MORNING LET ME PROPOSE THAT WHAT WE NEED NOWADAYS BECAUSE OF WHAT IS HAPPENING AROUND US & INSIDE US, IN OUR HEARTS, IS STRENGTH – STRENGTH OF HEART! SAY TO YOUR NEIGHBOR, “YOU NEED STRENGTH!”

CAN WE PAUSE FOR A WHILE AND THANK GOD FOR THIS AWESOME PRIVILEGE OF STUDYING GOD’S WORD THIS MORNING. PRAY...

PSALM 73 IS ASCRIBED TO ASAPH, A LEADER OF DAVID’S LEVITICAL OR WORSHIP TEAM OR LEVITICAL CHOIR. HERE AGAIN LIKE DAVID, ASAPH ADDRESSES ONE OF MAN’S DISTURBING QUESTIONS OR PROBLEMS OF THE SAINTS: HOW IS IT THAT THE WICKED SO OFTEN PROSPERS WHILE THE RIGHTEOUS OR GODLY SUFFERS SO MUCH? ASAPH GIVES US THE ANSWER AND MORE. HE WILL ACTUALLY POINT US TO THE KEY TO “A STRONG & UNSHAKABLE LIFE!”

NOW, MOVING TO OUR PSALM, WE FIND ASAPH IN VERSE 1 REFLECTING ON AN EXPERIENCE IN THE PAST THAT TAUGHT HIM A GREAT DEAL OF LESSON IN HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH THE LORD. AND THIS ASAPH BEGINS TO SHARE STARTING IN VERSE & FOLLOWING.

“God is indeed good to Israel, to the pure in heart...” (v. 1a)

THIS VERSE TELLS US WHAT ASAPH HAD LEARNED ABOUT THE LORD THROUGH HIS EXPERIENCE – **HE IS A GOOD GOD TO HIS PEOPLE ESP. TO THOSE WHO WALKS IN HOLINESS OR GODLINESS! HE DELIGHTS IN THEM!**

A. THE PSALMIST **EXPRESSES** THE CONFUSION IN HIS HEART!

LET US NOW PROCEEDS STUDYING THE PSALM. IN VERSES 1-16, ASAPH EXPRESSES THE **CONFUSION** IN HIS HEART. WHY IS THE WICKED PROSPERING AND I'M SUFFERING?

1) Asaph **entertains ENVY** in his heart!

*God is indeed good to Israel, to the pure in heart. But as for me, my feet almost slipped; my steps nearly went astray. **For I envied the arrogant; I saw the prosperity of the wicked.** They have an easy time until they die, and their bodies are well fed. They are not in trouble like others; they are not afflicted like most people. Therefore, pride is their necklace, and violence covers them like a garment. Their eyes bulge out from fatness; the imaginations of their hearts run wild. They mock, and they speak maliciously; they arrogantly threaten oppression. They set their mouths against heaven, and their tongues strut across the earth. **Therefore his people turn to them and drink in their overflowing words. The wicked say, "How can God know? Does the Most High know everything?" Look at them—the wicked! They are always at ease, and they increase their wealth.** (vv. 1-12)*

HERE, ASAPH TELLS US THAT HE WAS CONFUSED OVER WHAT WAS HAPPENING AROUND HIM AND CONFESSED THAT HIS FOOT "ALMOST SLIPPED" & HER ALMOST "LOST HIS FOOTING" BECAUSE HE HAS ALREADY ENTERTAINED A SINFUL AND VERY DESTRUCTIVE SPIRIT OR ATTITUDE IN HIS HEART - THE SPIRIT OF ENVY OR "PAGKA-INGGIT." HE IS ENVYING THE PROSPERITY OF THE WICKED AROUND HIM! (READ VV. 1-12). **ENVY IS DESIRING WHAT OTHERS HAVE THAT YOU DON'T HAVE.** TAKE NOTE THAT THIS EMOTION PRODUCED OTHER NEGATIVE EMOTIONS IN HIS HEART. NOT ONLY THAT HE IS **ENVOUS/JEALOUS** OF THE WICKED & RICH PEOPLE, BUT HE IS ALSO **ANGRY/"EMBITTERED"** AND

UPSET/HURT OR "WOUNDED INSIDE" AND BECAUSE OF THIS SEEMING INJUSTICE OR UNFAIRNESS TAKING PLACE AROUND HIM.

2) Asaph experiences NEGATIVE thinking & UNFRUITFUL living!

"Did I purify my heart and wash my hands in innocence for nothing? For I am afflicted all day long and punished every morning. If I had decided to say these things aloud, I would have betrayed your people. When I tried to understand all this, it seemed hopeless."
(vv. 13-16)

FIRST, TAKE NOTE THAT THIS ENVIOUS SPIRIT LED ASAPH TO THINK BAD & NEGATIVE THOUGHTS. HE NOW BEGINS TO ENTERTAIN THE THOUGHT THAT HIS PURSUIT OF MORAL PURITY & RIGHTEOUS-NESS IS BUT A BIG WASTE! (v. 13). THAT IT IS JUST FUTILE OR USELESS! SECOND, THIS SPIRIT HAS AFFECTED NOT ONLY THE WAY HE THINKS BUT ALSO THE WAY HE LIVES. VERSES 14-16 TELLS US THAT THIS SPIRIT HAS CAUSED HIM TO STRUGGLE EVERY DAY AND LIVE IN DEPRESSION AS SUGGESTED BY THE WORDS "A/FFLICTED/PLAGUED" AND "PUNISHED" AND "HOPELESS/OPPRESSIVE."

BUT THE GOOD NEWS IS THAT THIS EXPERIENCE BY THE PSALMIST DID NOT LAST FOR LONG! HE WAS ABLE TO OVERCOME IT. HE EXPLAINS THE REASON FOR THIS CHANGE OF HEART IN NEXT VERSES...

B. THE PSALMIST EXPLAINS THE CHANGE IN HIS HEART!

THEN, IN VERSES 17-24, HE EXPLAINS THE CHANGE IN HIS HEART. HE NOW UNDERSTANDS WHY ARE THESE THINGS HAPPENING.

TAKE NOTE THAT THE TURNAROUND HAPPENED WHEN HE WENT TO THE TEMPLE TO WORSHIP THE LORD! LOOK AT VERSE 17. TELL YOUR SEATMATE: "THERE ARE BLESSINGS WHEN WE WORSHIP!" OR "MAY BLESSING TALAGA ANG PAG-WORSHIP KAY LORD!"

1) An **ENCOUNTER** w/ the LORD in worship **ENLIGHTENS** Asaph!

*“When I tried to understand all this, it seemed hopeless **until I entered God’s sanctuary. Then I understood their destiny.** Indeed, you put them in **slippery places**; you make them fall into ruin. How suddenly they become a desolation! They come to an end, swept away by terrors. Like one waking from a dream, Lord, when arising, you will despise their image. When I became **embittered** and my innermost being was **wounded**, I was **stupid** and didn’t understand; I was an **unthinking animal** toward you.”* (vv. 17-22)

VERSES 17-22 TELLS US OF THE ENLIGHTENMENT THAT ASAPH RECEIVED FROM THE LORD WHEN HE WENT TO THE TEMPLE & TO WORSHIP GOD. VERSE 18-19 SAYS THAT **THE WICKED’S STATE OF PROSPERITY IS VERY TEMPORARY AND UNCERTAIN. THEY ARE STANDING ON “SLIPPERY GROUND.” THEY ARE A “DREAM” – THEY ARE NOT TRUE REALITY.** THE REAL THINGS ARE THE ETERNAL THINGS LIKE “FAITH” “LOVE” AND “WORSHIP.” THE REAL THINGS ARE THOSE THAT WE DO NOT SEE LIKE THE “FAITH”, “HEAVEN,” KINGDOM OF GOD.”

NOW, ASAPH UNDERSTANDS THAT THESE SINFUL EMOTIONS OR SPIRITS THAT HE HAD ENTERTAINED HAS CAUSED HIM TO BE **“HURT”** AND **“EMBITTERED”** MADE HIM LIKE A **“BRUTE BEAST”** OR **UNTHINKING ANIMAL** BEFORE THE LORD. **IN OTHER WORDS, WHAT HE WAS SAYING WAS: “WHAT I AM DOING IS SENSELESS AND IGNORANT!” “MY COMPLAINING & WHINING & FRETTERING WILL GET ME NO WHERE!” “IT IS USELESS!”**

2) An encounter w/ the LORD in worship **ENCOURAGES** Asaph!

*“**Yet I am always with you; you hold my right hand.** You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me up in glory.”* (vv. 23-24)

THIS ENCOUNTER WITH THE LORD NOT ONLY ENLIGHTENED HIM BUT ALSO ENCOURAGED HIM AS SUGGESTED BY VV. 23-24. READ THEM. WHAT HE LEARNED WAS THAT EVEN THOUGH HE WAS ACTING LIKE A BRUTE BEAST, THE LORD STILL LOVES HIM! PTL! TELL YOUR SEATMATE: “MAHAL KA NI LORD KAHIT MINSAN

AY UGALING ANIMAL KA!” I FOUND OUT AS I REFLECT ON THIS VERSE THAT THE PSALMIST IS A BAPTIST MEMBER! WHY HE BELIEVES IN ETERNAL SECURITY! LOOK AT VERSE 24. EVEN THOUGH HE SINNED AGAINST THE LORD, HE KNOWS THAT HE FORGIVES, RESTORES, AND ASSURES HIM OF ETERNAL LIFE. BECAUSE OF THIS HE, I BELIEVED HE WAS GREATLY ENCOURAGED.

I ALSO THINK THAT ASAPH WAS REMINDED OF WHO THE LORD IS & WHAT HE CAN DO! READ VERSE 28! HE SAW THE LORD AS THE SOVEREIGN LORD OF ALL!

C. THE PSALMIST **EXCLAIMS** THE CONFIDENCE OF HIS HEART!

AND FINALLY, IN VERSES 25-28, HE EXPRESSES THE **CONFIDENCE** OF HIS HEART IN THE LORD! HERE, ASAPH SPEAKS WITH RENEWED PASSION & DEVOTION TO THE LORD! HE NOW REVEALS TO US THE CONFIDENCE OF HIS HEART! HE IS NOW SHOWING HIS CONFIDENCE IN THE LORD AND WE CLEARLY SEE THIS IN THE **TWO COMMITMENTS** ASAPH **RESOLVES TO MAKE** AFTER REDISCOVERING THESE TRUTHS OF THE LORD WHILE WORSHIPING THE LORD IN THE TEMPLE.

1) Asaph **COMMITTS** his heart to **FOCUS** on the Lord!

*“Who do I have in heaven but you? And I desire nothing on earth but you. **My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart, my portion forever.**” (vv. 25-26)*

FIRST, HE RESOLVED TO HAVE A FOCUSSED HEART. HE COMMITTED HIS HEART TO FOCUS ON THE LORD. TAKE NOTE CAREFULLY WHAT HE COMMITTED TO DO AS FAR AS HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD IS CONCERNED -- **FIRST IS TO HAVE ONE DESIRE - ONLY THE LORD**, v. 25. AND THE **SECOND IS TO MAKE THE LORD THE STRENGTH OF HIS HEART**, v. 26.

CAN YOU ASK YOUR SEATMATE: “ANO ANG NAGPAPALAKAS NG PUSO MO? THE PSALMIST DECIDED ONCE AND FOR ALL – “I WILL MAKE THE LORD THE STRENGTH OF MY HEART!”

2) He **COMMITTS** his heart to be **FAITHFUL** to the Lord!

*“Those far from you will certainly perish; you destroy all who are unfaithful to you. **But as for me, God’s presence is my good. I have made the Lord God my refuge, so I can tell about all you do.**”*

(vv. 27-28)

FINALLY, ASAPH IN VERSE 27 HE DECLARES THE SURE DESTRUCTION OF ALL THOSE WHO ARE UNFAITHFUL TO THE LORD. BUT FOR HIM, IN VERSE 28, HE DECLARES HIS DECISION TO BE NEAR THE LORD; THAT IS, TO BE FAITHFUL TO THE LORD. AND TO MAKE THE LORD HIS REFUGE! THE NIV VERSION I THINK HAS A BETTER TRANSLATION OF VERSE 28.

*“But as for me, **it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign Lord my refuge;** I will tell of all your deeds.” (v. 28, NIV)*

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS:

FROM THIS PSALM OF ASAPH, WE LEARNED THAT

(1) IF WE ARE TO LIVE A **STRONG LIFE** IN THIS SIN-SICK & BROKEN WORLD, THEN WE NEED A **STRONG HEART!** AND THIS STRONG HEART CAN ONLY BE OURS THROUGH A **STRONG SAVIOR & SOVEREIGN LORD - JESUS** FOR HE IS **“THE STRENGTH OF OUR HEART”!**

THE STRENGTH THAT WE NEED TO OVERCOME LIFE’S CRISIS & DIFFICULTIES COMES NOT FROM OURSELVES BUT FROM THE LORD! FOR WE ARE REMINDED TODAY THAT OUR HEART HOWEVER STRONG WE THINK IT IS WILL STILL FAIL US! AS SHOWN BY THIS PSALM, THE TRUE & LASTING STRENGTH COMES NOT FROM US BUT FROM THE LORD! HE IS THE STRENGTH OF OUR HEART!

SCRIPTURES & EXPERIENCE HAS TAUGHT US THAT WE CAN PUT ANYTHING WE WANT IN OUR HEART OR ANOTHER WAY OF SAYING IT IS - WE CAN FOCUS OUR LIFE/HEART IN ANYTHING WE

WANT TO DO OR HAVE ASIDE FROM JESUS OUR KING. THE BAD NEWS IS THAT MANY PEOPLE INCLUDING BELIEVERS TODAY IS FOCUSING THEIR HEARTS IN EARNING MONEY & HAVING POSSESSIONS, IN SEEKING PLEASURES, IN SEEKING FAME OR POWER, INSTEAD OF FOCUSING IN THE LORD. THEY ARE FOCUSING THEIR HEARTS ON THE THINGS OF THIS WORLD INSTEAD OF CHRIST AND THIS EXPLAIN THE WEAKNESS & TROUBLES THAT WE ARE EXPERIENCING TODAY. LIKE ASAPH, WE HAVE TURNED OUR EYES AWAY FROM THE LORD & FOCUS IT ON WICKED PEOPLE ENJOYING THEIR RICHES & THE PLEASURES OF THIS WORLD. AND SO HE WAS DEPRESSED & EMBITTERED & HURT. BUT LATER HE REALIZED HIS ERROR & RESOLVED TO BE FOCUS HIS HEART ON THE LORD & TO BE FAITHFUL TO HIM!

BUT THIS PANDEMIC HAS TAUGHT US THE SURE & HARD LESSON THAT THESE THINGS ARE VERY TEMPORARY & THAT WHAT WE TRULY NEED IS A STRONG LIFE. WHY? BECAUSE EVEN OUR HEART WILL FAIL US? CRISIS LIKE THIS WILL BE THE NORM OF THE FUTURE OF THIS WORLD. LISTEN TO WHAT THE APOSTLE PAUL PREDICTED WILL HAPPEN.

“But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days.

People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God— having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people.” (2 Tim. 3: 1-5)

CHURCH/FRIENDS, WHAT WE ARE EXPERIENCING TODAY IS JUST THE BEGINNING OF THE TERRIBLE TIMES THAT PAUL WAS TALKING ABOUT. THEREFORE, WHAT WE NEED IN THIS LIFE IS NOT MORE MONEY OR POSSESSIONS OR MORE PLEASURES BUT A STRONG LIFE – A STRONG LIFE THAT COULD WITHSTAND THE EVILS OF THE TIMES, THE DIFFICULTIES THAT WE WILL FACE, THE PERSECUTIONS & OPPOSITION THAT WE WILL FACE BECAUSE OF OUR FAITH IN THE LORD JESUS.

AND IF NOT FOR OURSELVES, WE ARE TO PREPARE OUR CHILDREN FOR THESE COMING TERRIBLE DAYS SO THAT THEY ARE READY WITH STRONG LIVES & STRONG HEARTS TO FACE THESE TERRIBLE DAYS THAT ARE TO COME!

BUT HOW CAN WE MAKE OUR HEART, OUR LIFE STRONG?
PAUL ALSO GAVE THE KEY TO OUR STRONG HEART & LIFE – THE WORD OF GOD! DAVID LAST WEEK SHOWS US HOW WE CAN REVIVE & RESTOR OR REVIVE OUR LIFE THROUGH HIS WORD? THEREFORE, WE ARE TO GO DEEPER INTO THE WORD OF GOD. WE HAVE TO CULTIVATE A STRONG DEVOTIONAL LIFE IF WE ARE TO LIVE STRONG LIVES!

“In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, while evildoers and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.” (2 Tim. 3: 12-17)

CHURCH/FRIENDS, IS YOUR HEART STRONG TODAY? IT CAN ONLY BE STRONG IF THE LORD JESUS IS SITTING AS KING & LORD IN HIS THRONE IN YOUR HEART. IS THE LORD JESUS THE ONE SITTING ON THE THRONE OF YOUR HEART OR SOMETHING ELSE HAS TAKEN HIS PLACE? OR IT IS KING “SELF” IS THE ONE SITTING THERE? REMEMBER, WE CAN ONLY BE STRONG IF OUR HEART IS STRONG AND OUR HEART CAN ONLY BE STRONG IF IT IS FOCUS & FAITHFUL IN JESUS AS KING & LORD OF OUR LIFE!

PERHAPS, FOR SOME OF US WE HAVE TO STEP DOWN OF THAT THRONE OF OUR LIFE AND LET KING JESUS SIT AGAIN ON THAT RIGHTFUL THRONE OF OUR LIFE. WILL YOU DO THAT TODAY?

(2) LET US STOP ENVYING OTHERS, BEING UNFAITHFUL TO OUR GOD, & GIVING UP DOING WHAT IS GOOD! INSTEAD, LET US COME

TO THE LORD WITH AN HONEST & HEART-SURRENDERED WORSHIP AND HE WILL BEGIN TO CLARIFY THINGS FOTR US! THE LORD WILL HELP US SEE & UNDERSTAND THE FUTILITY OF ENVYING & BEING UNFAITHFUL AS WELL AS & THE FULFILMENT & SECURITY OF BEING FAITHFUL TO HIM!

BROTHERS & SISTERS/FRIENDS, ARE YOU HARBORING ENVY IAN YOUR HEART TODAY? ARE YOU GETTING WERY OF DOING GOOD & BEING FAITHFUL TO THE LORD & SERVING HIM BECAUSE OF WHAT YOU ARE SEEING AROUND YOU? PEOPLE DOING WHATEVER THEY WANT TO DO & DOING EVIL & LIVING IMMORAL LIVES BEFORE GOD & YET STILL ENJOYING GOOD HEALTH & ENJOYING ALL THE GOOD STUFF OF LIFE. AND YOU HERE YOU ARE PURSUING HOLINESS & DOING GOOD & BEING FAITHFUL TO THE LORD!

PERSONAL STORY- "ME & MY FAT PIG!"

I THINK I UNDERSTAND WHAT THE LORD WAS TELLING ASAPH HERE BECAUSE I HAVE EXPERIENCE THIS THING PERSONALLY IN MY LIFE. WHEN I WAS In HIGH SCHOOL I WAS TASKED TO TAKE CARE OF OUR PIGS. IT WAS A SIDE BUSINESS THAT MY DEAR MOTHER STARTED TO DO WHEN ALL OF 5 CHILDREN ARE IN HIGH SCHOOL & COLLEGE. SHE WANTED TO AUGMENGHT MY FATHER'S INCOME BY FATTENING A PIG FOR SEVDERAL MONTHS AND THEN ON THE APPONITED DAY, WE ARE GOING TO SLAUGHTER THE PIG & SELL ITS PARTS FOR PROFIT. THERE WERE DAYS ESP. MY DOWN DAYS WHEN I WILL ENVY THESE PIGS BECAUSE ALL THEY DO IS EAT & SLEEP & TAKE A BATH & ME – CLEAN THEIR POOPS, CLEAN THEIR PEN & PREPARE THEIR FOOD. MY MOTHER WOULD EVEN SENMD TO A RESTAURANT WHOM WE KNOW TO GET "KANIN-BAHOY" OR "PIG-FOOD" & I WAS SO ASHAMED THEN BECAUSE I WAS ALREADY A OVERLY CONSCIOUS TEEN-AGER & WANTED TO LOOK COOL WITH TEENAGERS GIRLS & DON'T WANT TO SEEN CARRYING A CONTAINER WITH THAT STINKING "PIG-FOOD." I HATED THAT PART OF MY TEENAGER. BUT MY POINT IN THE STORY IS THAT THESE PEOPLE THAT ASAPH WAS ENVIOUS ARE LIKE THESE PIGS – THEY ARE BEING TAKEN CARED OF & ARE BEING FATTENED IN ORDER TO PREPARE THEM FOR THE GREAT SLAUGHTER!

SO, CHURCH/FRIENDS, LET US NOT ENVY THESE PEOPLE AROUND US! LET US NOT GET WEARY OF DOING GOOD & OF BEING FAITH TO THE LORD FOR IN DUE TIME WE WILL REAP WHAT WE SOW! THESE EVIL PEOPLE AS WELL AS THOSE DISOBEDIENT BELIEVERS WILL REAP WHAT THEY SOW! LISTEN TO PAUL-

“Don’t be deceived: God is not mocked. For whatever a person sows he will also reap, because the one who sows to his flesh will reap destruction from the flesh, but the one who sows to the Spirit will reap eternal life from the Spirit. Let us not get tired of doing good, for we will reap at the proper time if we don’t give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us work for the good of all, especially for those who belong to the household of faith.” (Gal. 6: 7-10)

CHURCH/FRIENDS, DO NOT ENVY & DO NOT GIVE UP! INSTEAD, COME TO THE LORD & WORSHIP HIM. BE HONEST & OPEN YOUR HEART TO HIM & TELL HIM WHAT’S IN OUR HEART & HE WILL BEGIN TO CLARIFY THINGS TO YOU. HE WILL OPEN OUR EYES OF FAITH & YOU WILL BEGIN TO UNDERSTAND WHATEVER MAY BE BOTHERING YOUR HEART. WHY NOT DO IT TODAY? COME TO HIM & OPEN UP YOUR HEART TO HIM!

PRAYER:

“OUR HEAVENLY FATHER, THANK YOU FOR THIS PRIVILEGE OF WORSHIP! THANK YOU FOR THIS BLESSED TIME WITH YOU & WITH YOUR PEOPLE! THANK YOU LORD FOR THE BLESSING THAT WORSHIP BRINGS INTO OUR LIVES. YET MANY OF US ARE MISSING THESE BLESSINGS BECAUSE THEY HAVE PRIORITIZED OTHER THINGS RATHER THAN TO WORSHIP YOU TODAY WITH YOUR PEOPLE. FATHER GOD, FORGIVE US OF ENVYING OTHERS ESP. THOSE WHO ARE ABLE TO DO WHAT THEY WANT WITH THEIR LIFE EVEN DOING EVIL & STILL ENJOYING THE PLEASURES & RICHES OF LIFE.
