## **BIBLE STUDY GUIDE FOR FBC FAMILIES & E-GROUPS**

Sermon Title: "A PAUSE TO DRAW NEAR TO THE LORD!"

Sermon Text: 1 Thess. 5: 17

A. OPENING PRAYER (Father/Mother/E-Group Member)

B. SHARING TIME (Let each one share a brief summary of how's their week been!)

## C. ICEBREAKER QUESTION

"Share a memorable story on answered prayer that you personally experienced or heard!"

(<u>Transition Sentence</u>: "Thank you for your sharing. We have heard sermons & stories about prayer, but today we are going to study why a habit or discipline of prayer must be an integral part of our life as believers & followers of the Lord Jesus Christ...")

## C. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Read passage Let somebody read Hebrews 1 Thess. 5: 16-18.
- 2) What is the meaning of the phrase "without ceasing" or "continually" as used in 1 Thess. 5:17?
- 3) In his message, Pastor shared three important reasons why we pray as believers: [1] It proves that we are truly children of the Lord!, [2] It prepares/equips us for life's daily battles! We battle against our flesh, the Devil, & the world! [3] It provides us access to the miraculous or supernatural help of God!
  - a. From these reasons, what do you like the most & why?
  - b. From reason [1], How does prayer prove you are a child of God? (Eph. 1:13; Gal. 4: 6)
  - c. From reason [2], Which of the three enemies identified bothered you the most & why? How can we use prayer as a spiritual weapon? (Matt. 6: 9-13; Jn. 17: 15; Eph. 6: 18)
  - d. From reason [3] Do you believe that the Lord still intervenes in our daily life & does miracles in our behalf? Why or why not?
- 3) What is preventing you from pursuing a consistent & effective prayer life?
- 4) What significant change or resolution are you going to make to improve your prayer life starting today?

## D. PRAYER TIME & CLOSING PRAYER (Father/Mother/E-Group Leader/Member)

- 1) Ask the prayer concern/request of each one & pray for one another. You can do also do this by telling them to pray for the person on their right & left or pray together simultaneously.
- 2) The father/mother/Facilitator can close the meeting with a prayer.
