PSALM 94 – "THE LORD OF JUSTICE!"

"That's not fair!" We often hear this phrase being uttered by people. But the fact is life is not fair! This is because according to the Bible, God's Word, we are all sinners (Rom. 3:23). Unless our hearts are changed by the Gospel of Christ, we will not be able to do what is right & pleasing to God. Unless the Lord Jesus returns and restores His rule, there will be no true justice and fairness in this life. Our psalm today teaches us about the Lord being a JUST God. He will not let the guilty or the wicked go unpunished. For the mean time, He gives men the opportunity to repent and turn to His Son Jesus (2 Peter 3:9, 10). But in His perfect time, the Lord is going to ultimately destroy all the wicked and the evildoers!

1) The psalmist CALLS on the Lord to judge the wicked & evildoers of the earth! (vv. 1-15)

The psalmist recognizes the Lord as the just Judge of all the nations and the Avenger of His people. He also disciplines His people for their sins but He never abandons them. Instead, He teaches them and causes them to return to Him.

2) The psalmist CHALLENGES the saints to join him in fighting the wicked & evildoers! (vv. 16-23)

He encourages his hearers with the truth that their God will fight with them and will come to rescue them in their time of trouble. He also reminds them that the Lord will ultimately destroy all the wicked and evildoers.

Points to Ponder:

1) The Lord our God is the God of JUSTICE. He is the Avenger of His people and Destroyer of all the wicked. Therefore, let us wait upon the Lord and His justice with

patience knowing that He will return in due time to judge all in this earth. And as we wait for His return, let us live a life worthy of His Name & His calling.

Prayer:

"Our heavenly Father, we look forward to Your Return and Your judgment of this world. By faith we trust in Your promise and in due time You will destroy all our enemies and all the wicked people who reject You and do harm to Your people. Lord, as we wait grant us the patience and the persistent to live for Your glory and honor. Teach us to live holy lives and boldly share the Good News of salvation in Christ Jesus our Lord. In whose Name I pray all this. AMEN!"
