Psalm 30 – “The God Who Turns Things Around!”

Are you in an impossible situation today? I mean a very difficult situation that it seems hopeless or that no one or nothing could change it anymore? The good news is that the God of the Bible is a God of the impossible! He is a God who is in the business of making impossible things possible. In our psalm today, David exalts the Lord for being the God who “turns things around”!

1) *The Lord turns our PRISON into PRAISE! (vv. 1-5)*

David was exalting and praising the Lord because He “*lifted (him) out of the depths,*” “*brought (him) up from the grave,*” and “*spared (him) from going down the pit.*” He realizes that these are part and parcel of our daily experiences, but we can be confident that our “*weeping may last for the night but rejoicing comes in the morning.*” Indeed, David is teaching us that our God can turn our “prison” or “pit” experiences into a time of praising the Lord!

2) *The Lord turns our WAILING into REJOICING! (vv. 6-12)*

Similarly, David testified that the Lord answered his prayers and was merciful to him when he called for help. David experienced the divine intervention of the Lord for He turned his “wailing into dancing” and “removed his sackcloth and clothed him with joy.” Thus, David was forever thankful to the Lord and could not contain his heart from singing and rejoicing in the Lord.

POINTS TO PONDER:

1) *The God of the Bible, the God whom we worship & serve is an ALL POWERFUL GOD! Nothing is too difficult or impossible to Him! He will can turn things around in our life! Is He the God you are trusting?*

PRAYER:

“Father, You are the God of the impossible! You are the ALMIGHTY & POWERFUL God of the Bible! You turn our prison into praise and our weeping into rejoicing! You are worthy of our praise,

our thanksgiving and worship. To You I will fix eyes of faith & place my trust & hope. In Jesus' Name, AMEN!"
