MOBILITY MANAGEMENT

Mobility management is a relatively new strategic approach to managing transportation resources.

Programs are funded by 5310 FTA funds & overseen by the ConnDOT

MOBILITY IS IMPORTANT

- » Most activities are outside of our homes.
- » A more mobile workforce with access to training and job sites.
- » Access to preventive and follow-up care
- » Higher quality of life with independent travel
- » Work, shopping, and social events.
- » If people can't get to the agencies, they can't access their services, and the agencies cannot fulfill their mission to provide life-enhancing services. Economic implications.

- 2012 CTC received grant that established regionalized transportation among five communities that lacked adequate transportation
- Today CTC is now comprised of six public partners
 (Acton, Boxborough, Concord, Littleton, Maynard and Westford) and eight private partners bound together by Intermunicipal Agreements which is focused on increasing mobility and commuting options while also reducing traffic congestion and air pollution
