



Rodeo Volunteer FAQs

What should I wear?

Layers are always good since it may be cool in the morning and then warm up later. We recommend dressing in light-colored comfortable clothing as the day has traditionally been warm. It's always a good idea to bring some light rain gear as the event goes off rain or shine! Sneakers and shorts are acceptable, but remember that you are representing your agency and this is a professional event.

What should I bring?

We have been very fortunate for several years to have the event on beautiful hot and sunny day. Make sure to bring water, plenty of sunscreen, and sunglasses. As a volunteer you will get a Rodeo hat and breakfast and lunch are provided.

Who can volunteer?

It is our hope that every agency can provide some volunteers to help us with a great event. We ask that all volunteers be 18 years or older.

Will I be outside all day?

Yes. This is an outdoor event with very limited shady areas provided by tents. Volunteers should be comfortable being exposed to the sun for the duration of the event.

What time should I arrive?

If you plan to volunteer please arrive on time at 7:45 AM to check in and plan to stay until the end of the event at approximately 2:00 PM. It is very difficult to fill in for volunteers who don't show up at the last minute or who show-up late. Please help us run a smooth and efficient event by arriving on time and ready for the day.
