




Technical DVD's for the home builder, made in Australia for Australian hotrod enthusiast

DVD shows much of the build, including: Manufacturing and setting up of the accessory drives; Making a stainless steering column; Where to start to ensure correct fitment of fenders; Flaring the brake lines and much more.
