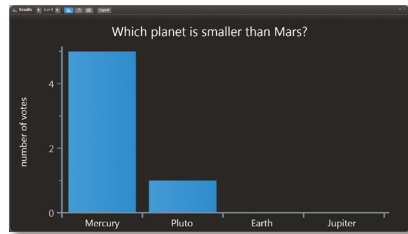


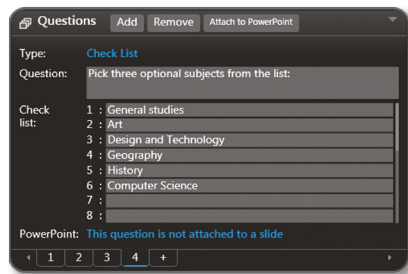
Bring your own device with Wordwall's **Respond Everywhere**

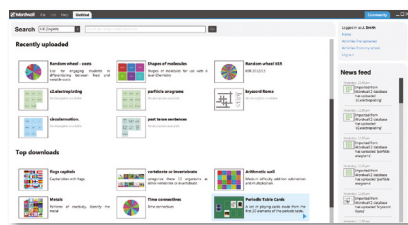
Assessing pupils' progress

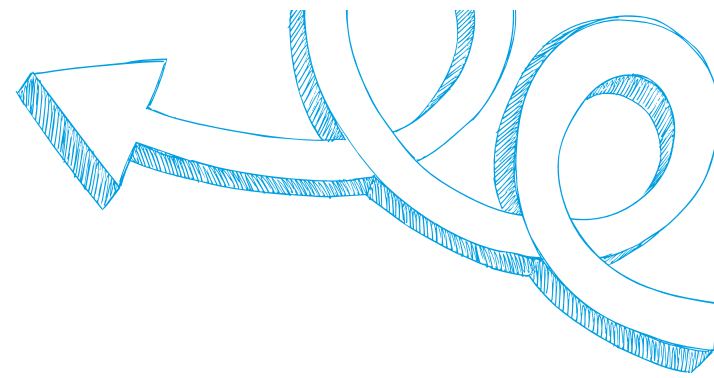
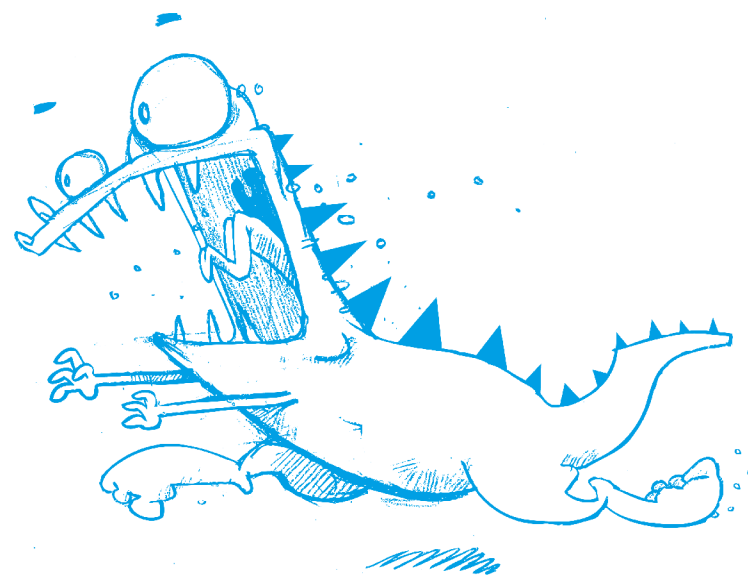
Use with Powerpoint

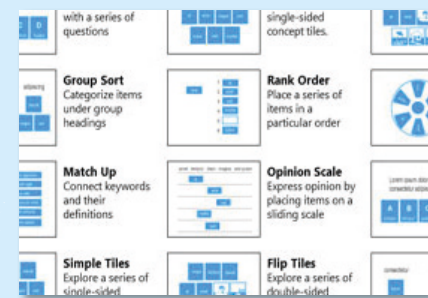

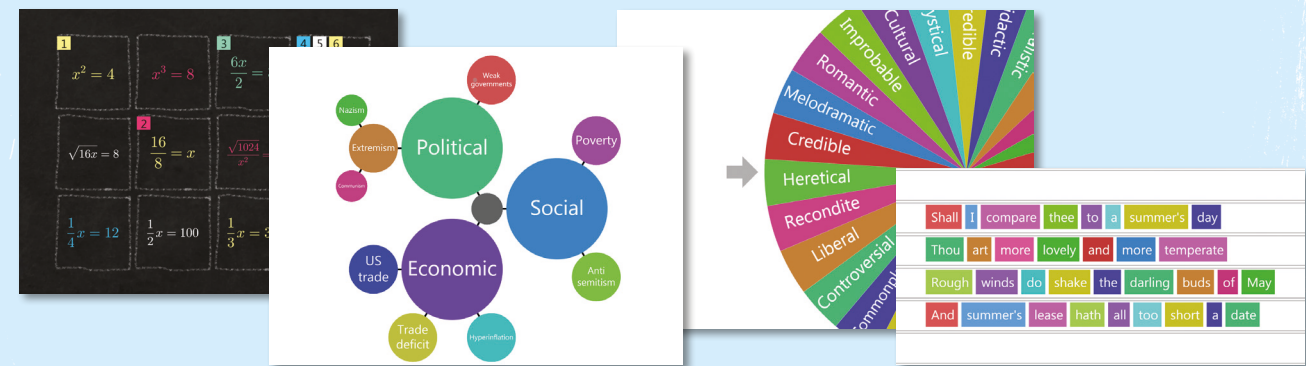

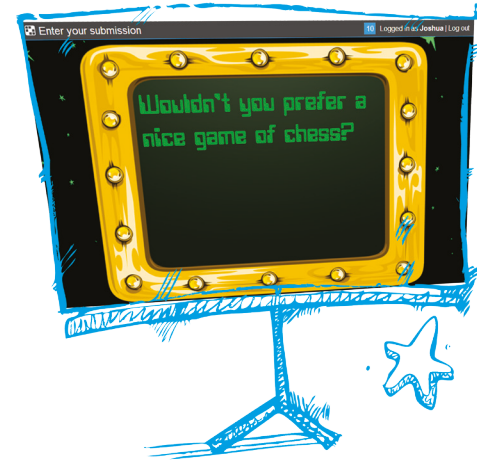

Wordpad activities



Joypad

A great 32 player computer game for the classroom. Students navigate their player chip around the screen answering questions, against the clock, against the class. You get a point for each question you answer correctly. Will you make it onto the leaderboard? It's a fantastic plenary, because you can use the assessment data to demonstrate progress and plan your next lesson.



Text Brainstorm

Contribute an idea and slap it on the virtual post-it board. With the brainstorm game, every student has a voice, even those who wouldn't normally speak out. Starting a lesson with a brainstorm really gets students thinking about their own ideas and is a great basis for classroom discussion.



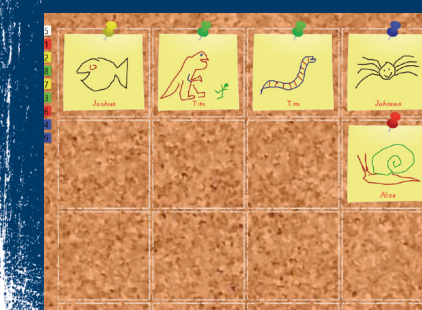
Rating Scale

Do you agree or disagree? Evaluating ideas is just as important as coming up with them in the first place. You can either use teacher-provided keywords or convert the information from a text brainstorm activity. When applied to their own ideas, it encourages students to think more deeply about their beliefs or conceptions. Use it before and after paired discussion to show how opinions have changed – then ask them why!



Quiz

Fastest finger first or a proper assessment? You do a quick fire game show style activity where students buzz in to answer questions – a fun revision activity. Or you can conduct a real test under timed conditions, where students progress through the test at their own pace. After the test, students can immediately review their results individually.*



Sketch tiles*

A great tool that enables students to express themselves visually. It's like Pictionary en masse. Students can draw an image on their own tablet, using the pen tools. Their artistic endeavour can then be shared with the whole class.
