

Treeline Therapy Centre Covid-19 Consent Form

In order for us to meet your needs at this time, please read the following statement and sign to provide consent that you wish to continue with treatment.

Please ask any questions prior to attending for your treatment, this is very important and we wish to do all that we can to answer your questions where we are able to. Please ensure you seek guidance from Government website, Public Health England and/or NHS, all of which can provide useful, up to date information to assist you at this difficult time.

Staff Health - At this moment your practitioner is not exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 infection. The practitioners will test their temperature on a daily basis to catch symptoms early.

Patient Health - Please do not attend for your treatment if you are showing any signs of COVID-19 (please see Government and Public Health England for symptoms). You will not be charged for cancelling.

Hygiene - The practitioners are washing their hands between treatments and using anti-bacterial spray at least once every hour otherwise. Hand sanitiser is available for everyone's use but we require patients to wash their hands on entering the premises prior to any treatment. All hard surfaces (treatment couches, chairs) are wiped with antibacterial spray between patients. Commonly handled items (door handles, card machine etc.) are wiped with antibacterial wipes between every patient.

PPE - Personal Protective Equipment will be worn by your therapist. Disposable PPE will be changed between patients.

We ask that patients wear a mask and use the antibacterial spray provided.

Distancing - All practitioners are following social distancing measures outside of work.

Treatments are booked with at least 30 minutes between to allow time for cleaning and to avoid interaction between patients. Please arrive for your treatment on time for us to follow these measures. If you are early for your appointment please wait in your car until your treatment time. Please do not be late for your appointment. If you are late and a patient is booked in after you, we will need to cancel your appointment and you may still be charged.

High Risk Patients - Those who are in the high risk demographic (aged over 70, pregnant, immune compromised, respiratory conditions such as asthma, COPD etc.) are advised NOT to receive care.

COVID-19 This virus spreads easily, especially person to person through close contact (within 2 meters) and through respiratory droplets via coughing and sneezing. It is possible for this virus to spread through people who are not symptomatic but carry the virus.

Ultimately, we are doing all that we reasonably can to minimise the risk while providing treatment. However we cannot eliminate risk, especially as COVID-19 can be spread by those showing no symptoms.
