George Weston foods moved their manufacturing facilities to the DON KRC site in Castlemaine. As a result the site demanded a great deal more power for extra loads requiring a 5MvA Co-Generation Facility and 5 extra substations.

The project involved:

- All materials procurement.
- Installation of all cable ladders and conduits.
- Installation and Termination of all cabling.
- Connection to Co-Generation Facility.
- Installation of all Transformers.
- Installation of all Ring Main Units (RMUs).
- Design and Installation of Earth Fault Current Grid.
- Full Inspection and Certification.
- Supply AS-BUILTS and O&M Manual.
