RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I, the undersigned, understand and hereby acknowledge and agree that participation in rowing/sculling involves certain risks and dangers which include, but are not limited to, cold weather and water. In consideration of my request to engage in rowing/sculling activity, accompanied or unaccompanied (meaning with or without launch), using Muskoka Rowing Club (hereafter referred to as the Club), or private equipment, I agree not to hold the Club, its Directors, Officers or Agents (including Coaches) liable for personal injury, death and/or property loss. I further agree and acknowledge that:

- ☐ I have read the safety check list posted in the boathouse and assume responsibility for examining such list for any changes or additions;
- ☐ I acknowledge and confirm that I can swim;
- ☐ I am familiar with and understand the dangers associated with cold weather and water, specifically hypothermia and how to deal therewith should an accident occur;
- ☐ I agree to keep updated regarding special activities and programs ongoing at the Club, also, to be bound by all rules established by the Club;
- ☐ I agree to immediately notify a Club officer or employee of all incidents within my knowledge affecting the club or its members, also, regarding any obstruction or situations in or on the water and surrounding banks.
- ☐ I give permission for the Muskoka Rowing Club to obtain photographs and/or videotaped footage for training or promotional purposes.

MUSKOKA ROWING CLUB PROGRAMS & FEES 2017

MEMBERSHIP TYPE	FEES
LEARN TO ROW Sign up for this option if you have never rowed before. A "Learn to Row" course is a requirement for any person who has never rowed before. To ensure quality instruction, the number of participants is limited on a first-come, first-served basis. The course consists of one dry-land orientation session and a minimum of 5 on-water sessions. Once completed, the rower may continue with learn-to-row sessions and in addition have unlimited rowing for the remainder of the season. For those just wishing to attend the Learn to Row clinic, there is the option of paying \$175, and if they wish to continue for the season there is an additional fee of \$200.	\$175 for LTR + additional \$200 if continuing for season
ADULT RECREATIONAL Sign up for this option if you have previously held a membership with the Muskoka Rowing Club or another recognized rowing club, and have previously completed an instructional rowing course. A "Return to Row" program will be offered Monday evenings, 5:45 pm to 8:00 pm once the docks are in for those who wish to partake, as well as assistance given to those who are seeking a crew to row with.	\$ 350.00
SECOND ADULT RECREATIONAL Applies to a second adult from the same household (\$100 deduction)	\$250.00
STUDENT RECREATIONAL Any person under who is enrolled in a full-time course of study at the elementary, secondary or post-secondary level is eligible to row at this lower membership rate. It includes participation in a Learn to Row session and unlimited rowing for the season.	\$ 200.00
COMPETITIVE ROWER (Adult or Student) A competitive upgrade fee is required for all competitive rowers, ie, anyone wishing to take part in a regatta. This fee includes additional Row Ontario and Rowing Canada fees, and is in addition to regular membership fees.	+ \$ 72.00 to regular fee
HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SEASONAL For students who row either just for the spring/fall high school season or just for the summer season (July/Aug). A good option for students who row for another club during the high school season but cottage in Muskoka.	\$125.00
SPRING HIGH SCHOOL For students rowing for the spring season until mid-June. For those wishing to continue for the rest of the season there is an additional \$125 fee.	\$75.00

REFUND POLICY

Requests for refunds of membership fees will only be considered if received **in writing**. Requests must be directed to the MRC Board at PO Box 784, Bracebridge, Ontario P1L 1V1 or hand-delivered to a MRC Board Member. Non-refundable portions of the membership fee include those funds used to cover initial administration and registration costs, Learn to Row Course and Row Ontario and Rowing Canada Aviron fees. The remaining portion of the membership fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Board on a pro-rated basis. There are NO REFUNDS on Competitive Program fee
