


What is glaucoma?

The eye and a bicycle tire have one thing in common. Both require the right amount of internal pressure for safety and performance. Glaucoma is a disease associated with increased fluid pressure within the eye which can damage the optic nerve causing progressive blindness.¹

Not only is it incurable, but it can result in progressive **irreversible** vision loss that can lead to blindness, if left untreated.⁴




There are symptoms to warn me.

Gluacoma is known as the "silent thief of sight" and can progress without symptoms.⁵ Patients can lose as much as **40% of their sight** before they know they have glaucoma.⁶


