

World leaders in incineration technology...

Incinco have completed two 500kg/hr incinerators for the Barrick Gold Pascua-Lama project in South America.

The units have been shipped to the mine site which dissects the Argentina/Chile boarder high in the Andes mountains - one unit has been delivered to each country.

The project - started back in 2010 - involved Incinco designing the bespoke plant for this unique and demanding location. To meet the exacting environmental requirements both units incorporate full gas cleaning equipment calibrated for use at over 5000m above sea level.

The units also incorporate Incinco's full package of ancillary equipment - bin tippler, ram loader, reciprocating and riddling grates, full auto ashing via ash conveyor, waste oil burner and heat exchanger.

The equipment was constructed and fully tested at our Telford facility for final sign-off by the client. Installation and commissioning will take place on site early in 2012 - the only window before the weather deteriorates for the next winter period.
