## CLUBS AND PROGRAMS

### Power Hour:

Power Hour helps Club members ages 6-18 achieve academic success by providing homework help, tutoring and high-yield learning activities and encouraging members to become self-directed learners.

### Fine Arts:

Programs in this area enable youth to develop their creativity and cultural awareness through knowledge and appreciation of the visual arts, crafts, performing arts and creative writing.

### LEAP (Literacy Enrichment & Arts Program):

Focused primarily on 1st-3rd grade students, LEAP combines reading, both individually and in groups, with fun story-centered art projects, drama, videos, and activities to make reading fun. Different themes are used to guide LEAP activities during each session.

### Triple Play Program:

Boys & Girls Club of America's first comprehensive health and wellness program, developed in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, strives to improve the overall health of Club members ages 6-18 by increasing their daily physical activity.

### Snack and Dinner Program:

Each BGC Site provides a FREE healthy snack for Club members daily after school. Berard Center and Teen Center will also provide a FREE dinner daily after school. Club sites which are open on No School Days will provide Club members with a FREE healthy lunch and snack. Dinner and snack is provided by USDA and WalMart. USDA is an equal opportunity provider and employer.
